

- ✓ It implies, additional authentication will not be need for payment of ₹15,000 per transaction.
- ✓ Under e-mandate, an individual can give standing instruction to the bank to debit a specific amount automatically on a recurring basis.

- ✓ UPI is already accepted in UAE, Singapore and Bhutan.
