- ✓ China is the largest gold producer in the world for many years and accounts for 11% of the world production. It is followed by Australia (at Rank 2) and Russia (the third-largest producer).
- ✓ India is one of the largest consumers of gold in the world. India gets its gold from Kolar Gold Fields (KGF), Lava Gold Mines in Jharkhand, Sonbhadra Mines in UP, Parasi mines in Jharkhand etc.
- ✓ Karnataka is the largest producer of gold in India. Kolar gold fields (KGF) and Hutti goldfields are two major goldfields located there.
- ✓ The first gold mine in India was Kolar Gold Fields.
- ✓ The largest gold ore reserves are found in Bihar, followed by Rajasthan.

- The first modern Olympics were held in Athens, Greece, in 1896
- Olympic Day was celebrated on 23 June
- 5 Olympic ring colors represent each continent
- Blue for Europe, yellow for Asia, black for Africa, green for Oceania, and red for America
- Abhinav Bindra became the first Indian to win an individual Olympic gold medal.
- Bindra had achieved the feat during 2008 Beijing Olympics and the 10 metre air rifle shooter
- Javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra becomes first Indian to win Olympic Gold in Athletics (track and field events).
- Neeraj Chopra threw a best attempt of 87.58m to win the Olympic gold at the Tokyo Olympics 2020.
- Neeraj Chopra also became the second Indian to win an individual Olympic gold medal after Abhinav Bindra.
- PV Sindhu became 2nd Indian after Sushil Kumar to win 2 individual Olympic medals.
- PV Sindhu became the first Indian woman to win two Olympic medals.
- She had won the silver medal at the 2016 Rio Olympics and Bronze medal 2020 Tokyo Olympics.
- Saina Nehwal became the first Indian to win a medal in Badminton at the Olympics, by winning the bronze medal at the London Olympics 2012
- India's first individual medal at the Olympics came at the 1952 Games in Helsinki when Khashaba Jadhav won the bronze in freestyle wrestling
- First Indian woman to win an Olympic medal Weightlifter Karnam Malleswari gave Indian women at the Sydney Games in 2000
- India first participated at the Olympic Games in 1900
- India's hockey team is the most successful team ever in the Olympics, having won eight gold medals
- In 1928, the Indian Hockey team won its first Olympic gold medal
- Nilima Ghose first Indian woman to participate in the Olympic Games Helsinki 1952
- Women competed for the first time at the 1900 Games in Paris
- India has won 35 medals (10 Gold + 9 Silver + 16 Bronze) at the Olympics since the 1900 edition.
- India made its first appearance in the Summer Olympics in the year of 1920
- India finished the Games with its best-ever Olympic medal tally of 7 in Tokyo Games 2020.
