- ✓ It comprises 24 members and is elected in the General Assembly of the Convention according to the principles of equitable geographical representation and rotation.
- ✓ Members of the Committee are elected for a term of four years.
- ✓ India has 14 intangible cultural heritage elements on the prestigious UNESCO Representative List of ICH of Humanity.
- ✓ Other than the Durga Puja there are 13 Traditions in India recognised by UNESCO as ICH.



- ✓ This project has led to savings on land acquisition and construction costs and also reduced the travel time to the city's airport.
- ✓ This double-decker viaduct made possible a three-layered transport corridor with the first layer occupied by pre-existing highway, the second layer by a flyover highway, and the third layer by Nagpur metro rail.
- ✓ The flyover highway is built at the height of 9 meters, and the metro at 20 meters. While 2.7 km of this multi-layered corridor has a four-lane road on its second level, half km has a six-lane road.
