- ✓ She defeated opposition candidate Yashwant Sinha with 676,803 electoral votes (64.03% of total) in 21 of the 28 states (including in the union territory of Puducherry).
- ✓ Murmu will be replacing incumbent President Ram Nath Kovind, whose tenure ends on July 24, 2022.
- ✓ She will be administered oath by the CJI, Mr. NV Ramana and assume the office on July 25, 2022.
- ✓ Droupadi Murmu is a tribal leader from Rairangpur in the Mayurbhanj district in Odisha.
- ✓ She is the first-ever politician from Scheduled Tribe (ST) community as well as from Odisha to be elected as the President of India.
- ✓ Draupadi Murmu has become the 15th President of India after winning against the opposition's candidate Yashwant Sinha.
- ✓ Draupadi Murmu become India's First Tribal and second woman to hold the post after Pratibha Patil.
- ✓ She is also the youngest President.
- ✓ She had served as the ninth Governor of Jharkhand from 2015 to 2021, becoming the first woman Governor of Jharkhand.
- ✓ She was a presidential candidate for the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) in the 2022 election.
- ✓ Draupadi Murmu was born in a Santali tribal families in Uparbeda village of Mayurbhanj district in Odisha
- ✓ Santhal or Santal are India's third largest scheduled tribe community after Gonds and Bhils.
- ✓ Murmu joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in 1997 and was elected as the councillor of the Rairangpur Nagar Panchayat.
- ✓ Odisha's tale of two presidents, Droupadi Murmu and VV Giri.
- ✓ VV Giri, the first President from Odisha.
- ✓ Dr. Rajendra Prasad was the first President of India.

- ✓ On July 24, 2022, the Chinese space agency successfully launched the second of three modules needed to complete its new Tiangong space station, under its ambitious space programme.
- ✓ The uncrewed craft is named Wentian, which literally means "quest for the heavens".
- ✓ This module was launched by a Long March 5B rocket from the Wenchang launch centre on China's tropical island of Hainan.
- ✓ The first and central module called Tiangong, which means "heavenly palace", was launched in April 2021.
- ✓ The third and final module named Mengtian, is scheduled to be launched in October 2022.
- ✓ Until the final module arrives, the space station will have a "rather unusual L-shape".
- ✓ Once all the three modules are complete, the Tiangong space station will acquire T-shape.
- ✓ The Tiangong space station will be around 20% as massive as the International Space Station (ISS), which has a mass of about 460 tons.
- ✓ It must be noted that China has been excluded from the International Space Station (ISS) since 2011, when the United States banned NASA from engaging with the country, so China is setting up its own space station.

- ✓ India has been supporting the work of UNRWA and is committed to the wellbeing of Palestine refugees through timely contribution to the agency.
- ✓ Since 2018, India has contributed around USD 20 million in support of core UNRWA services to Palestine refugees across the Middle East.
- ✓ The UNRWA was established as a humanitarian agency in 1949. The agency is fully funded through voluntary contributions and grants from donor countries.
- ✓ In 2022, UNRWA needs US\$1.6 billion from the international community to cover expenses and provide services and humanitarian development programs for Palestinian refugees.
- ✓ UNRWA headquarters : Amman, Jordan and Gaza, Palestinian Authority.

- ✓ However, the campaign of Indian contingents ended with one silver medal, which was earned by Neeraj Chopra in the javelin throw event.
- ✓ The United States has topped the medal tally with overall 33 medals, which include 13 gold, 9 silver, and 11 bronze medals.
- ✓ It is followed by Ethiopia (10 [4-4-2]) and Jamaica (10 [2-7-1]) at second and third place respectively.
- ✓ A total of 179 nations plus the Athlete Refugee Team took part in the event.
- ✓ The moto of the World Athletics Championship 2022 was Feel the Glory.

- ✓ Centre has made changes in the Flag Code of India 2002 allowing the tricolour to be flown by the public both day and night.
- ✓ This is in line with the "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign launched by the government from August 13 to 15 as part of the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' to commemorate 75 years of a progressive independent India.
- ✓ Under the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union home minister Amit Shah have appealed to every citizens to hoist the tricolour at their homes from August 13 to 15.
- ✓ It must be noted that the display, hoisting and use of the Indian national flag is governed by the Flag Code of India, 2002 and the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971
- ✓ Amendments made in Flag Code of India, 2002
- ✓ First amendment permits tricolour to be flown day and night. Earlier, the tricolour was allowed to be flown from sunrise to sunset, irrespective of weather conditions.
- ✓ The Flag Code of India, 2002 has been amended through an order on July, 20, 2022 and clause (xi) of paragraph 2.2 of Part-II of the Flag Code of India, 2002 shall now be read as under: (xi) "where the Flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, it may be flown day and night"
- ✓ Similarly, in December 2021, the government had amended the provision for material used to make the Indian flag. Now machine made and polyester material can also be used for making flag. Earlier machine made and polyester flags were not allowed to be used.
- ✓ The amendment in December 2021 said, "The National Flag shall be made of handspun and hand woven or machine made, cotton/ polyester/ wool/ silk khadi bunting."

- ✓ It's also an important habitat for king cobra, according to the Cachar Forest Division.
- ✓ Named after the second-largest river in the northeast, the Barak Valley is home to 550 species of birds and 100 species of mammals.

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- ✓ The classification is the highest alert that the WHO can issue and follows a worldwide upsurge in cases.
- ✓ Kerala reports India's first confirmed monkeypox case.
- ✓ More than 16,000 cases have now been reported from 75 countries.
- ✓ There have been five deaths so far
- ✓ World health organization previously declared emergencies for public health crises such as the Covid-19 pandemic, the 2014 West African Ebola outbreak, the Zika virus in Latin America in 2016 and the ongoing effort to eradicate Polio.
