- ✓ Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) has topped the 2021 Rankings with 7.6 crore passengers in terms of passenger footfall in the year 2021.
- ✓ From India, the Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport in New Delhi has been ranked among the top 20, as the 13th busiest airport. IGIA witnessed 3.7 crore passengers footfall in 2021, which is 30.3% more than 2.8 crore in 2020, when IGI was ranked 16th.
- ✓ The list of top 20 busiest airport represents 19% of global traffic (863 million passengers).
- ✓ The ranking provides a view of air transport demand across the world's airports in three areas: passengers (international and domestic), air cargo (freight and mail) and aircraft movements (air transport movements and general aviation).
- ✓ Airports Council International (ACI) Established in 1991, its headquarters (ACI World) are based in Montreal, Quebec, Canada.

- ✓ **Pichavaram Mangrove** : Pichavaram mangrove is located in a village near Chidambaram in Cuddalore District of Tamil Nadu
- ✓ **Pala wetland** : The Pala wetland is the largest natural wetland in Mizoram.

- ✓ **What are Ramsar Sites**
- ✓ A Ramsar Site is a wetland site designated to be of international importance under the Ramsar Convention. The name Ramsar comes from Ramsar City of Iran, where this treaty was signed.
- ✓ The Convention on Wetlands is also known as the Ramsar Convention. It is an intergovernmental environmental treaty established in 1971 by UNESCO and came into force in 1975.
- ✓ Wetlands declared as Ramsar sites are protected under strict guidelines of the convention.
- ✓ The aim of the Ramsar list is to develop and maintain an international network of wetlands which are important for the conservation of global biological diversity and for sustaining human life through the maintenance of their ecosystem components, processes and benefits.

- 2nd February 2022 marked the 51st anniversary of the Ramsar Convention, the day which is also celebrated as World Wetlands Day.
- Uttar Pradesh's Haiderpur Wetland Recognized as 47th Ramsar Site in India.
- Four new sites of India added to Ramsar list as 'wetlands of International importance (Thol - Gujarat, Wadhvana-Gjarat, Sultanpur - Haryana & Bhindawas -Haryana).

- It is also known as the Convention on Wetlands and is named after the city of Ramsar in Iran.
- Ramsar Convention or the Convention of Wetlands was established in 1971 and came into force in the year 1975, upon receipt by UNESCO.
- Ramsar convention came into force on 1 December 1975.
- India signed the Ramsar Convention on 1 February 1982.
- Sundarban wetlands are the largest Ramsar site in India.
- Chilika Lake (Orissa) and Keoladeo National Park (Rajasthan) were recognized as the first Ramsar Sites of India.
- Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of 10 Ramsar sites in India.
- Renuka Wetland in Himachal Pradesh is the smallest wetland of India.
- Chilka lake and Keoladeo Ghana National Park is the oldest Ramsar site in India which was declared in 1981.
- World's First Ramsar site was identified in 1974, which was the Cobourg Peninsula in Australia.
- The United Kingdom has the world's largest number of Ramsar Sites i.e. 175.
- Bolivia has the largest area under Ramsar protection.
- There are a total of 2400 Ramsar Sites in the world, including 54 Ramsar sites in India
- The Ramsar Convention works with the collaboration of the following organizations:
  - International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN).
  - Birdlife International.
  - International Water Management Institute (IWMI).
  - Wetlands International.
  - Wildfowl & Wetlands Trust (WWT)

- ✓ This is the first time that India will host the FIDE Chess Olympiad since its inception in 1927.
- ✓ The official logo and mascot of the Olympiad is a chess knight called Thambi (meaning Younger brother in Tamil).
- ✓ AR Rahman unveils anthem 'Vanakkam Chennai' for 44th International Chess Olympiad.
- ✓ The All India Chess Federation (AICF) on signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Tamil Nadu government for the forthcoming 44th Chess Olympiad, slated to be held here from July 28 to August 10.
- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the historic torch relay for the 44th Chess Olympiad at Indira Gandhi Stadium in New Delhi.
- ✓ A record 187 countries will participate in the event, making it the world's biggest chess event.
- ✓ A total of 188 teams in the Open section and 162 in the Women's section will participate in the Olympiad.
- ✓ From India, total 30 Indian players will take part across six teams (Three in open and three women).
- ✓ The main venue of the Chess Olympiad will be the convention centre at the Four Points by Sheraton, while the opening and closing ceremonies will be held at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (also known as the Marina Arena) Chennai.
- ✓ The Chief Arbiter of the event will be France's International Arbiter Laurent Freyd.

- ✓ The first commonwealth games were held in 1930 at Hamilton, Canada.
- ✓ India for the first time participated in the second commonwealth games held in 1934 in London.
- ✓ India hosted the 19th Commonwealth games in 2010 in New Delhi.
- ✓ After Olympics, Commonwealth Games is the second-largest sports festival in the world.
- ✓ Since 1930, the games have been conducted every four years except for 1942 and 1946.
- ✓ Australia has hosted the Commonwealth Games five times i.e. in 1938, 1962, 1982, 2006, and 2018, this is more times than any other nation.
- ✓ England have hosted the Games on two occasions, in London during 1934 and in 2002 in the North West region of England and the city of Manchester. They will welcome the Commonwealth for a third time on the twentieth anniversary of the Manchester Games, as the city of Birmingham prepares to host the 2022 edition.
