- ✓ The project PHSPP aims to increase the resilience and preparedness of India's health system for a pandemic and support activities for strengthening existing health units at points of entry and establishing new health units at PoEs.
- ✓ The EHSDP aims to support comprehensive primary health care service delivery in some prioritised states.

- ✓ This project is in line with the Jal Jeevan Mission, a national flagship programme of Government of India, which aims to provide piped water to all rural households by 2024.
- ✓ It will connect 75,800 households to the service, providing uninterrupted water supply to about 370,000 residents across 10 districts

Investments will foster much-needed infrastructure in Meghalaya state that will lead to the establishment of 5 ecotourism circuits. The project includes the construction of 114km of roads and bridges. NDB will also direct USD 70 million to the Lamphelpat Waterbody Rejuvenation Project.
- ✓ In China, NDB approved EUR 265 million for the expansion of the Lanzhou Zhongchuan International Airport and RMB 805 million for the expansion of the Xi'an Xianyang International Airport.
- ✓ In Brazil, NDB will channel USD 300 million that will contribute to connecting 592 thousand households to water supply and 727 thousand to sewage collection networks in the state of Sao Paulo. It also promotes environmental protection by augmenting wastewater treatment capacity, among other development outputs.

- ✓ Ultra-mega scale firms with Rs 50 crores investment and a minimum of 510 employees has to create 50 jobs

- ✓ Only 37,241 rural households (36.54 per cent) out of a total of 1,01, 905 households in Burhanpur had potable drinking water through tap connections at the time of the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August 2019.
- ✓ In addition to the households, all 640 schools, 547 Anganwadi centres and 440 other public institutions now also have tap connections. The 440 public institutions include 167 Gram Panchayats, 50 healthcare centres, 109 community centres, 45 ashramshalas, 2 community toilets and 67 other government offices



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- ✓ The villages confirm that every household is getting a regular supply of water of prescribed quality and that there are no leakages from the distribution pipeline in the village, and that all the roads dug up to lay the water pipeline are restored upon completion of the water supply works.
- ✓ Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC) has been formed in all 254 villages. VWSC is responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of water supply infrastructure developed under 'Har Ghar Jal' programme.
- ✓ Goa, Telangana and Haryana, A&N Islands, D&N Haveli & Daman & Diu and Puducherry have provided 100 per cent tap water coverage.
- ✓ As per the report, Burhanpur is the only district in the country where all people in each of the 254 villages have access to safe drinking water through taps, ensuring that 'No One is Left Out'.
- ✓ Burhanpur district is also known as the 'Darwaza of Dakhin'.

- ✓ Rajashekara is joined as a 2022 laureate by Viktor Orlov, chief specialist of the Centre for Innovative Technologies (Rosatom in Russia) and pioneer in thermonuclear physics; and Mercuri Kanatzidis, professor of chemistry and materials science at Northwestern University and senior researcher at the Argonne National Laboratory.
- ✓ The awarding ceremony will be held during Russian Energy Week in Moscow on October 12-14.

- ✓ It must be recalled that India shuttler P.V. Sindhu was chosen as the female flagbearer of the Indian contingent.
- ✓ The Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games Organising Committee made it mandatory for each nation to name two Flagbearers, one male and one female, for the Opening Ceremony.
- ✓ Manpreet Singh led the Indian men's hockey team at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics in 2021, which won bronze medal.

- ✓ XXII Commonwealth Games 2022 : Birmingham, England
- ✓ XXIII Commonwealth Games 2026 : Australia
- ✓ XXIV Commonwealth Games 2030 Canada
- ✓ The first commonwealth games were held in 1930 at Hamilton, Canada.
- ✓ India for the first time participated in the second commonwealth games held in 1934 in London.
- ✓ India hosted the 19th Commonwealth games in 2010 in New Delhi.
- ✓ After Olympics, Commonwealth Games is the second-largest sports festival in the world.
- ✓ Since 1930, the games have been conducted every four years except for 1942 and 1946.
- ✓ Australia has hosted the Commonwealth Games five times i.e. in 1938, 1962, 1982, 2006, and 2018, this is more times than any other nation.



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- ✓ England have hosted the Games on two occasions, in London during 1934 and in 2002 in the North West region of England and the city of Manchester. They will welcome the Commonwealth for a third time on the twentieth anniversary of the Manchester Games, as the city of Birmingham prepares to host the 2022 edition.

- ✓ India lost 329 Tigers and 307 Elephants in 3 years between 2019 and 2021
- ✓ As per a recent data presented by Union Minister of State for Environment Ashwini Kumar Choubey, India lost 329 tigers in the last three years, between 2019 to 2021.
- ✓ These deaths were recorded as 96 tigers in 2019, 106 in 2020 and 127 in 2021. The cause of death mainly included poaching, natural and unnatural causes.
- ✓ The data showed that 68 tiger did due to natural causes, 5 died because of unnatural causes, while 29 deaths were attributed to poaching and 30 to 'seizure'. Death cause of 197 tiger are still under scrutiny.
- ✓ However, the number of poaching cases was found to be reduced from 17 in 2019 to four in 2021.
- ✓ A similar survey was done for elephants also. This survey revealed that as many as 307 elephants died between 2019 and 2021 due to poaching, electrocution, poisoning and train accidents.
- ✓ The cause of deaths in the last three years is shown below:
- ✓ 222 elephants died due to electrocution. Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Assam reported 41, 34 and 33 such deaths, respectively.
- ✓ 45 elephants have died in train accidents. Odisha and West Bengal reported 12 and 11 such deaths respectively.
- ✓ 29 elephants have died due to poaching. Meghalaya and Odisha reported 12 and 7 such deaths respectively.
- ✓ 11 elephants have died due to poisoning, which included 9 in Assam.

- India lost 329 tigers in the last three years, between 2019 to 2021.

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- ✓ It must be noted that the display, hoisting and use of the Indian national flag is governed by the Flag Code of India, 2002 and the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971
- ✓ Amendments made in Flag Code of India, 2002
- ✓ First amendment permits tricolour to be flown day and night. Earlier, the tricolour was allowed to be flown from sunrise to sunset, irrespective of weather conditions.
- ✓ The Flag Code of India, 2002 has been amended through an order on July, 20, 2022 and clause (xi) of paragraph 2.2 of Part-II of the Flag Code of India, 2002 shall now be read as under: – (xi) “where the Flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, it may be flown day and night”
- ✓ Similarly, in December 2021, the government had amended the provision for material used to make the Indian flag. Now machine made and polyester material can also be used for making flag. Earlier machine made and polyester flags were not allowed to be used.
- ✓ The amendment in December 2021 said, “The National Flag shall be made of handspun and hand woven or machine made, cotton/ polyester/ wool/ silk khadi bunting.”
