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- ✓ Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has constituted a special task force (STF) to monitor monkeypox cases in India.
- ✓ NITI Aayog member (health) VK Paul will be the head the task force.
- ✓ Other members of the STF will include officials from the Health ministry and representatives of the major medical and research institutes in the country.
- ✓ The STF has been tasked to monitor and provide guidance to the government on the expansion of diagnostic facilities and to explore vaccination for the infection in the country.
- ✓ So far, India has reported four Monkeypox cases, which includes three cases in Keralas and one in Delhi
- ✓ **MONKEYPOX**
- ✓ Monkeypox is a viral zoonotic disease with symptoms similar to smallpox, although with less clinical severity.
- ✓ The infection was first discovered in 1958 following two outbreaks of a pox-like disease in colonies of monkeys kept for research — which led to the name ‘monkeypox’.
- ✓ **SYMPTOMS** : Infected people break out in a rash that looks a lot like chicken pox. But the fever, malaise, and headache from Monkeypox are usually more severe than in chicken pox infection.
- ✓ **TRANSMISSION** : Primary infection is through direct contact with the blood, bodily fluids, or cutaneous or mucosal lesions of an infected animal. Eating inadequately cooked meat of infected animals is also a risk factor.
- ✓ Human-to-human transmission can result from close contact with infected respiratory tract secretions, skin lesions of an infected person or objects recently contaminated by patient fluids or lesion materials.
- ✓ **TREATMENT AND VACCINE**: There is no specific treatment or vaccine available for Monkeypox infection,
- ✓ But the European Union has recommended a Small Pox Vaccine, Imvanex to treat monkeypox after the WHO declared monkeypox a global health emergency.

- ✓ The central bank also disbursed 2,000 coins to commercial banks.



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- ✓ Any individual or company can buy the coins from authorised outlets such as banks.
- ✓ The decision to launch the gold coin as legal tender was taken by the government to moderate the very high demand for the US dollar, as the high demand is not being matched by supply.

- ✓ The device-based tokenization framework will now be applicable to Card-on-File Tokenisation (CoFT) services as well. Card-on-File (CoF) means that the Credit/Debit card details are stored by merchants for ease of payment
- ✓ Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has released guidelines to ease the transition to new norms on card-on-file (CoF) tokenization and licensing of payment aggregators (PAs) in two separate notifications.
- ✓ While reiterating that with effect from October 1, no entity in the card transaction chain, other than card issuers and card networks, shall store CoF data, the central bank notified two interim measures.
- ✓ Other than the card issuer and the card network, the merchant or its PA involved in settlement can save the CoF data for a maximum period of four days after the transaction date or till the settlement date, whichever is earlier. This data shall be used only for settlement of such transactions, and must be purged thereafter.
- ✓ For handling other post-transaction activities, acquiring banks can continue to store CoF data until January 31, 2023.
- ✓ On guidelines for PAs and payment gateways, the RBI took note of the disruption caused by the pandemic and allowed a fresh window for all PAs existing as on March 17, 2020 to apply for authorization. They will now be allowed to apply by September 30, 2022 and shall have a net worth of Rs 15 crore as on March 31, 2022.
- ✓ They will also be permitted to continue their operations till they receive communication from the RBI regarding the fate of their application. The timeline of 31 March 2023 for achieving a net worth of Rs 25 crore will remain.
