- ✓ A Ramsar Site is a wetland site designated to be of international importance under the Ramsar Convention. The name Ramsar comes from Ramsar City of Iran, where this treaty was signed.
- ✓ The Convention on Wetlands is also known as the Ramsar Convention. It is an intergovernmental environmental treaty established in 1971 by UNESCO and came into force in 1975.
- ✓ Wetlands declared as Ramsar sites are protected under strict guidelines of the convention.



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- ✓ The aim of the Ramsar list is to develop and maintain an international network of wetlands which are important for the conservation of global biological diversity and for sustaining human life through the maintenance of their ecosystem components, processes and benefits

- Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of 10 Ramsar sites in India by Tamil Nadu that has 10 such sites.
- Renuka Wetland in Himachal Pradesh is the smallest wetland of India.
- Chilka lake and Keoladeo Ghana National Park is the oldest Ramsar site in India which was declared in 1981.
- World's First Ramsar site was identified in 1974, which was the Cobourg Peninsula in Australia.
- The United Kingdom has the world's largest number of Ramsar Sites i.e. 175. and Mexico (142).
- Bolivia (148,000 sq. kms) has the largest area under Ramsar protection.
- There are currently over 2,424 Ramsar Sites around the world. They cover over 2.5 million square kms, an

- ✓ India, the world's second-largest producer, importer, and consumer of coal, has historically imported more coking coal used mainly in steelmaking from Russia, with Australia being the other key supplier.
- ✓ Thermal coal imports from Russia jumped 70.3% in July, compared with June, to a record 1.29 million tonnes, while coking coal imports rose by over two-thirds to more than 280,000 tonnes.
- ✓ Overall Indian coal imports, including shipments of anthracite and PCI coal, were nearly 10% lower in July at 23.8 million tonnes, compared with record imports of 26.29 million tonnes in June.
- ✓ China is the world's largest producer of coal.
- ✓ India is second on the list of the world's largest coal.
- ✓ Jharkhand has the largest reserves of coal in India followed by Odisha and Chhattisgarh

- ✓ Built at nearly \$180 million, the spacecraft is carrying six science instruments, including a camera for Nasa. It's designed to peer into the permanently shadowed, ice-filled craters at the lunar poles. Nasa favours the lunar south pole for future astronaut outposts because of evidence of frozen water.
- ✓ South Korea has also planned to land its own spacecraft on the moon by 2030.
