- Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U) is a flagship Mission of Government of India being implemented by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).
- ✓ The mission was launched on June 25, 2015, to ensure a pucca house to all eligible urban households by the year 2022.
- Union Budget 2022 has allocated Rs 48,000 crore towards the PMAY scheme (Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana) and completion of 8 million houses.
- ✓ About Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U)
- ✓ Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) Mission was launched on 25th June 2015.
- Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana's (Urban) aim is to provide housing for all in urban areas by the year 2024.
- The Mission provides Central Assistance to the implementing agencies through States/Union Territories (UTs) and Central Nodal Agencies (CNAs) for providing houses to all eligible families/ beneficiaries against the validated demand for houses for about 1.12 cr
- ✓ As per PMAY(U) guidelines, the size of a house for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) could be up to 30 sq. mt. carpet area, however, States/UTs have the flexibility to enhance the size of houses in consultation and approval of the Ministry

- Antrix, the commercial arm of ISRO, made this money by launching 345 foreign satellites from 34 different nations.
- > ISRO 'Human Spaceflight Expo' inaugurated at Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium in Bengaluru.
- > ISRO plans mission to Venus by December 2024.
- > ISRO used PSLV to launch 345 foreign spacecraft from 34 different nations since 1999.
- > India's first human space mission "Gaganyaan" will be launched in 2023.

Act also designated the centre as an institute of national importance
- ✓ Important features of the bill include:
- ✓ Bill rechristens the New Delhi International Arbitration Centre as India International Arbitration Centre.
- ✓ 2019 had allowed the central government to provide for removing any difficulties in implementing the act for 2 years from the date of commencement. Under the bill, this time period has been extended to 5 years.
- ✓ Bill also amends various drafting errors in 2019 act.

- ✓ The world's highest railway bridge is built on the Katra-Banihal railway line.
- ✓ The bridge is 359 meters high from the river surface.
