For landing on the moon, the crew will use SpaceX's Starship, a system that the California company is developing right now for crewed human missions
- ✓ Artemis 3 is the third scheduled flight of the Artemis program

- ✓ Monkeypox is a viral zoonotic disease with symptoms similar to smallpox, although with less clinical severity.
- ✓ European Union has recommended a Small Pox Vaccine, Imvanex to treat monkeypox after the WHO declared monkeypox a global health emergency.
