- > Darjeeling Tea was the first Indian product to get the geographical indication tag in 2004.
- The second GI tag in India was given to Aranmula Kannadi (Handicraft) which is a mirror and made in Kerala.

- > A GI is registered for an initial period of ten years, which must be renewed after 10 years.
- > Karnataka has the highest number of GI tags i.e. 47 products followed by Tamil Nadu (39).

- A GI is a sign used on products that have a specific geographical origin and possess qualities or a reputation that are due to that origin.
