- ✓ Sabarmati Riverfront has been developed on the banks of the Sabarmati River in the city of Ahmedabad, Gujarat

- ✓ These bright blue Coradia iLint trains are built by French TGV-maker Alstom, which are costlier than diesel powered trains but eco-friendly.
- ✓ The green trains can travel 600 miles (1,000km) and a maximum speed of 140 kph (87 mph) on a single tank of hydrogen, similar to the range of diesel trainsl
- ✓ Hydrogen trains are equipped with fuel cells that produce electricity by combining hydrogen with oxygen.
- ✓ This conversion process only emits steam and water, thus producing zero emissions.
- ✓ Excess energy produced is stored in ion-lithium batteries on board train

- Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh inaugurated a seven-storeyed Flight Control System (FCS) Integration facility in Bengaluru, Karnataka.
- The facility is housed at Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE), a laboratory of DRDO.
- > DRDO successfully flight tested the Man Portable Anti-Tank Guided Missile (MPATGM) in its final "deliverable configuration". at minimum range, which is 200-300 metres.
- MPATGM will be manufactured by Bharat Dynamics Limited at its facility in Bhanoor, Telangana.
- ➤ DRDO successfully test-fired an extended range sea-to-sea variant of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile on January 11, 2022 for the Indian Navy.
