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

- ✓ It is a state-of-the-art modern combat helicopter, primarily designed for deployment in high-altitude regions.
- ✓ LCH is the only attack helicopter in the world which can land and take-off at an altitude of 5,000 m with a considerable load of weapons and fuel.
- ✓ LCH has a range of 550 km and an operational ceiling of 6500 m. It is armed with air-to-air and air-toground missiles, 70 mm rockets and a 20 mm gun.
- ✓ The induction of LCH in the Indian Air Force is expected to provide further impetus to Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan

- ✓ The overall cost of the redevelopment of these 199 stations as well as the New Delhi, CSMT and Ahmedabad railway stations is Rs.60,000 crore.
- ✓ The progress the re-development work of station with 10 lakhs and above will begin in the second phase.

- POSHAN Abhiyaan (National Nutrition Mission)
- POSHAN Abhiyaan (National Nutrition Mission) is a flagship programme of the Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD), Government of India, launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at Jhunjhunu in Rajasthan on the occasion of the International Women's Day on March 8, 2018.
- ✓ Financial Outlay: The National Nutrition Mission (NNM) has been set up with a three year budget of Rs.9046.17 crore commencing from 2017-18. This will be funded by Government Budgetary Support (50%) and 50% by IBRD or other MDB.
- ✓ Government budgetary support would be 60:40 between Centre and States/UTs, 90:10 for NER and Himalayan States and 100% for UTs without legislature. Total Government of India share over a period of three years would be Rs. 2849.54 crore.
- Objective : The goals of NNM are to achieve improvement in nutritional status of Children from 0-6 years, Adolescent Girls, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers in a time bound manner during the next three years beginning 2017-18.
- ✓ Implementation Strategy and Targets : NNM targets to reduce stunting, under- nutrition, anemia (among young children, women and adolescent girls) and reduce low birth weight by 2%, 2%, 3% and 2% per annum respectively.
- ✓ Although the target to reduce Stunting is atleast 2% p.a., the mission would strive to achieve reduction in Stunting from 38.4% (NFHS-4) to 25% by 2022 (Mission 25 by 2022).

- Rabindra Nath Tagore gave the title of Mahatma to Gandhi and the father of the Nation was given by Subash Chandra Bose.
- ✓ The first Satyagraha movement led by Mahatma Gandhi was the Champaran satyagraha.
- ✓ It was started in the Champaran district of Bihar in 1917.
- ✓ This satyagraha was a revolt against the British indigo policy.
- ✓ Gandhiji arrived in Champaran on the request of Pandit Raj Kumar Shukla, one such oppressed Indigo cultivator.
- ✓ The Champaran Satyagraha of 1917 was the first Satyagraha movement led by Gandhi in India.
- ✓ While Gandhi Ji first conceived satyagraha in 1906 in South Africa
- ✓ At Pietermaritzburg railway station of South Africa was Mahatma Gandhi evicted from the first-class compartment of the train in 1893 due to racial discrimination.
- ✓ In 1894, Mahatma Gandhi founded the Natal Indian Congress in South Africa.
- In 1910, Mahatma Gandhi founded Tolstoy farm near Johannesburg
