



- ✓ The 'Connecting Economic Clusters for Inclusive Growth in Maharashtra' project will develop the state's core road network. It will help connect underdeveloped rural communities with more opportunities, improve access to health and social services and improve agricultural value chains

- ✓ The Central Government introduced the provision for EWS reservation in admissions and public services, through the 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019.
- ✓ The Supreme Court pronounced the judgement on a batch of pleas challenging the validity of the amendment. A five-judge Constitution bench headed by Chief Justice Uday Umesh Lalit upheld the 10 percent quota for EWS in a 3:2 split verdict.
- ✓ Though the Chief Justice had struck down the amendment, the majority bench upheld the act.
- Q.4. Which organisation has released the 'State of the Global Climate in 2022' report?

- The World Meteorological Organization released the provisional State of the Global Climate in 2022 report.
- ✓ As per the report, the past eight years are on track to be the eight warmest on record, fuelled by rising greenhouse gas concentrations and accumulated heat. It also cited that extreme heat-waves, drought and devastating flooding have affected millions and cost billions this year.

- ✓ Instead, only electric vehicles used as public transport will be allowed into the area.
- ✓ All 252 water bodies and 24 forests in the area will also be revived.
- ✓ The eight key cities of Mathura, Vrindavan, Gokul, Barsana, Baldeo, Gokul, Nandgaon, Govardhan and Mahavan will also be connected through an inland water system and a narrow-guage railway line
- ✓ The existing 12.9 km railway line connecting the twin cities of Mathura and Vrindavan will be redeveloped, providing pilgrims access to Krishna Janma Bhoomi and Dwarkadhish temple in Mathura, and Banke Bihari and other temples in Vrindavan.

- Russia, which imported 0.2% of all oil by India in March 2022, has supplied 9,35,556 barrels per day of crude oil to India in October (highest ever).
- ✓ In June 2022, Iraq was top oil supplier, while Russia was at second.

- ✓ He has accomplished this feat in final Super 12 stage match against Zimbabwe at Melbourne.
- ✓ He has scored 61 not out of just 25 balls, consisting of six fours and four sixes.
- ✓ In 2021, Pakistan wicketkeeper-batter Mohammad Rizwan scored 1,326 runs at an average of 73.66.
 Rizwan scored a century and 12 half-centuries that year, with the score of 104* (not out).
