- ✓ The Ahom-era 'Moidams' (cemetery of the royal family) in Assam's Charaideo district will be India's only nomination for recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- The 'Moidams' of the Ahom dynasty at Charaideo were first included in the tentative list of UNESCO World Heritage Site in April 2014.
- ✓ 'Moidems' will be nominated in the category of cultural sites.
- India currently has 40 World Heritage Sites 32 of them cultural sites, seven natural sites and one mixed site.
- Currently, Kaziranga National Park and Manas National Park in Assam in the Northeast are among the seven natural sites while there is no World Heritage Site in the cultural heritage category.

#### UNESCO IN NEWS 2022-23.

- Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma announced that the Centre has nominated the maidams of Ahom Kingdom in Charaideo to seek a UNESCO World Heritage Site tag.
- The historic maidams of Ahom Kingdom in Charaideo were chosen out of 52 sites for the UNESCO World Heritage Site tag.
- Three new cultural sites in India, including the iconic Sun Temple at Modhera, historic Vadnagar town in Gujarat, and rock-cut relief sculptures of Unakoti in Tripura, have been added to the tentative list of UNESCO world heritage sites....
- Franca Ma-ih Sulem Yong gets UNESCO Madanjeet Singh Prize for 2022.

- ✓ To honour and remember Netaji's indomitable courage and selfless service to the nation, the Government of India decided to celebrate his birthday on 23 January every year as Parakram Divas.
- ✓ Subhash Chandra Bose and his Role in Indian Independence Struggle
- ✓ Subhash Chandra Bose was born on 23 January 1897 in Cuttack, Orissa Division, Bengal Province to Prabhavati Dutt Bose and Janakinath Bose.

- ✓ In 1919, he passed the Indian Civil Service (ICS) examination. Later he resigned from this post.
- He was deeply influenced by the teachings of Vivekananda and regarded him as his spiritual master.
   His political mentor was Chittaranjan Das.
- ✓ He worked with Jawaharlal Nehru and became the Congress Party's young leaders gaining popularity among the people.
- ✓ He advocated complete Swaraj and was in favour of using force to achieve it.
- Bose's ideology was inclined towards socialism and leftist authoritarianism. He formed the All India Forward Bloc in 1939 as a faction within the Congress.
- ✓ He arrived in Singapore from Germany in July 1943, from where he issued his famous slogan 'Delhi Chalo' and announced the formation of the Azad Hind government and the Indian National Army on 21 October 1943.
- Bose inspired the soldiers with his fiery speeches. His famous quote is, "Give me blood, and I will give you freedom!"
