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

- ✓ India's Harnaaz Sandhu was crowned Miss Universe 2021, the third Indian to win the crown after Sushmita Sen (1994) and Lara Dutta (2000).
- ✓ The Miss Universe pageant was founded in 1952 by Pacific Mills, a California-based textile company.
- ✓ The first Miss Universe pageant was held in 1952 in Long Beach, California.
- ✓ Armi Kuusela of Finland won the first Miss Universe title.

- ✓ Recently the National Council of Education Research and Training (NECRT) has notified India's first National Assessment Regulator "PARKH" with the aim of setting up assessment guidelines for all boards.
- ✓ PARAKH stands for Performance Appraisal, Review and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development.
- ✓ It will act as a component of NCERT.
- ✓ It is also entrusted with the task of conducting periodic learning outcome tests like National Achievement Survey (NAS) and State Achievement Survey.
- ✓ This framework will also act to check the emphasis on rote learning as envisaged by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- ✓ Its team comprises prominent evaluation experts with a deep understanding of the education system in India and internationally
- ✓ Objective of PARAKH:
- ✓ **Uniform Norms and Guidelines**: To lay down norms, standards and guidelines for student assessment and assessment across all recognized school boards in India.



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- ✓ Improvement in assessment pattern: It will act to encourage school boards to change their assessment pattern towards meeting the skill requirements of the 21st century.
- ✓ **Reducing disparity in evaluation :** This will bring uniformity across state and central boards that currently follow different standards of evaluation, leading to wide disparities in marks.
- ✓ Benchmark Assessment: The benchmark assessment framework will address the issues contained in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

- ✓ Patna Circle of the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has discovered two 1200-year-old miniature stupas during landscaping activities near the Sarai Tila mound within the complex of the world heritage site 'Nalanda Mahavihara' in Nalanda district of the state.
- ✓ The figures of Buddha are shown on the stupa carved out of stone.
- ✓ These stupas carved out of stone depicting figures of Buddha are about 1200 years old.
- ✓ Such stupas were popular as votive offerings in India as early as the 7th century.
- ✓ About the Stupas?
- ✓ The stupa is a hemispherical structure symbolising the burial mound of the Buddha.



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- ✓ It rose to prominence after the advent of Buddhism and reached its peak during the reign of Ashoka.
- ✓ Stupas evolved from chortens in Tibet and pagodas in East Asia.
- √ Nalanda Mahavihara site complex
- ✓ Nalanda was a Mahavihara, a large Buddhist monastery in the ancient kingdom of Magadha (modern Bihar) in India.
- ✓ It is considered by historians to be the world's first residential university and one of the largest centres of learning in the ancient world.
- ✓ It was established during the Gupta Empire period.
- ✓ Archaeological Survey of India (ASI)
- ✓ Founded: 1861
- ✓ Founder : Alexander Cunningham
- ✓ Headquarters : New Delhi
- ✓ Director General : V Vidyavathi
- ✓ ASI is responsible for archaeological research and the conservation and preservation of cultural and historical monuments in India.

- ✓ According to a report, P. Sreekumar, the Satish Dhawan Professor at the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and advisor to its space science programme, stated in a talk that the organization has not yet received approval from the Indian government for the Venus mission and that, as a result, the mission may be delayed until 2031
- ✓ The mission was scheduled to launch in December 2024.
- ✓ The best time to launch from Earth to Venus is once every 19 months or thereabouts. In case it misses the 2024 window, ISRO has "backup" launch dates in 2026 and 2028. But every eight years, new better windows present themselves that further cut down on the quantity of fuel needed for takeoff.
- ✓ The VERITAS and EnVision missions of the American and European space agencies, respectively, both have Venus missions scheduled for 2031, but China might go anytime: 2026, 2027, whenever they want to go.

ISRO UPCOMING SPACE MISSION IN NEWS

- ➤ ISRO 'Shukrayaan I' mission to planet Venus reportedly shifted to 2031.
- > ISRO's Venus mission Shukrayaan was expected to be launched in December 2024.
- ➤ ISRO-NASA joint satellite project NISER proposed to be launched early 2023
- > Gaganyaan: ISRO partners with France to launch India's first human spaceflight mission in 2023



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- Lunar Polar Exploration mission (LUPEX): ISRO's Lunar Polar Exploration Mission in collaboration with JAXA (Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency) will be launched in the year 2024
- Mars Orbiter Mission 2 (MOM 2) also called Mangalyaan 2 is expected to launch in the year 2024.
- ➤ ISRO Chairman S Somnath said that Chandrayaan-3 (C-3) launch will be in June next year onboard the Launch Vehicle Mark-3 (LVM3). He said, ISRO plans to fly Indian astronauts into orbit by the end of 2024.
- ➤ ISRO is setting the stage to deploy Aditya-L1, the first dedicated mission of the country to study the Sun, into space in the first few months of 2023
