- ✓ Administrator Balwari Lal Purohit inaugurated a 2MWp capacity solar plant on January 23, 2023, with the aim of making the city self-sufficient in power generation by the Chandigarh administration.
- ✓ North India's largest floating solar plant has been installed at Chandigarh's Water Works.
- Apart from this, Balwari Lal Purohit also inaugurated a 500 kWp floating solar power plant in Dhansa Lake.
- ✓ The solar plant with 2MWp capacity will generate 28 million units of electricity. Also, due to the installation of panels on water, this project will reduce the evaporation of about 382 million litres annually.

#### FLOATING IN NEWS 2022 – 23

- World's largest floating solar power plant will be built on Omkareshwar Dam on the Narmada River in Khandwa, Madhya Pradesh at an estimated cost of over Rs 3000 crores with a capacity of 600 Megawatt.

- ✓ Programs to be organised for the first time in 74th Republic Day Parade
- ✓ This was the first Republic Day celebrations hosted at the ceremonial boulevard after Rajpath was renamed to 'Kartavya Path' last year.
- ✓ For the first time, 12 women riders were part of the Border Security Force's (BSF) camel contingent and 16 march contingents of the armed forces.
- ✓ The old howitzers with 25-pounder guns, which traditionally thundered during the 21-gun salute during Republic Day celebrations, were replaced by 105 mm Indian field guns this year.
- A team of "Daredevils" motorcycle riders from the Corps of Signals, co-led by a woman officer, became part of the parade for the first time.
- ✓ Nine Rafale aircraft and the Navy's IL-38 participated in the air show for the first time.
- Besides the IL-38 aircraft, the formations like 'Bheem' and 'Vajrang' showcased over the Kartavya Path for the first time.
- ✓ It is the first time that the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Abdel Fattah el-Sisi, has been invited as the chief guest on the Republic Day.
- During the Beating Retreat Ceremony 2023, 3-D anamorphic projection was held for the first time on the façade of North and South Block.
- ✓ Newly appointed Agniveer was also a part of the parade for the first time.
- ✓ The Narcotics Control Bureau also presented a tableau for the first time.

- ✓ President Droupadi Murmu on 25 January approved 412 Gallantry awards, including six Kirti Chakras and 15 Shaurya Chakras for Armed Forces personnel and others on the eve of the 74th Republic Day.
- These include six Kirti Chakras, including four posthumous, and 15 Shaurya Chakras including two posthumous.
- ✓ These include one Bar to Sena Medal (Gallantry), 92 Sena Medals, including four posthumous, one Nao Sena Medal (Gallantry), seven Vayu Sena Medals (Gallantry) and 29 Param Vishisht Seva Medals.
- ✓ The Kirti Chakra is India's second highest gallantry award after the Ashoka Chakra. The Shaurya Chakra is the country's third highest gallantry award.
- ✓ The President has also awarded the President's Tatrakshak Medal to Indian Coast Guard personnel for conspicuous gallantry, exceptional devotion to duty and distinguished service.
- ✓ Kirti Chakra Awardees
- ✓ Major Shubhang of the Dogra Regiment from Indian Army
- ✓ Naik Jitendra Singh of the Rajput Regiment from Indian Army

- Recently it has been revealed through a satellite picture that China is building a new dam on the Yarlung Zangbo (Brahmaputra) river in Tibet near the tri-junction of India, Nepal and Tibet, which remains a matter of concern for India.
- ✓ By increasing the construction activities in the areas adjacent to the Indian border, China is installing military equipment and its related equipment there.
- ✓ The Chinese dam follows the announcement of plans to build a large dam downstream of the Yarlung Zangbo in 2021 to generate 70 gigawatts of electricity.
- ✓ This is nearly three times the power produced by China's Three Gorges Dam, the largest hydroelectric power plant in terms of installed capacity.
- This came after China unveiled plans to build a super dam close to the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in Tibet on the lower reaches of the Yarlung Zangbo river which flows into Arunachal Pradesh and then in Assam..
- ✓ Yarlung Zangbo (Brahmaputra) River:
- ✓ The Brahmaputra River is known as the Yarlung Tsangpo in China.
- ✓ Origin Source:- Mansarovar Lake
- ✓ Total length 2,880 km.
- ✓ Tibet:- 1,700 km.
- ✓ Arunachal Pradesh and Assam :- 920 kms.
- ✓ Bangladesh:- 260 km.

#### **CHINA IN NEWS 2022-23**

- China is building a new dam on the Yarlung Zangbo (Brahmaputra) river in Tibet near the trijunction of India, Nepal and Tibet, which remains a matter of concern for India.
- The biggest decline in the population of China has been recorded after the year 1961. Negative population growth has now started in China.
- China became the first country in Asia and second in the world to launch Hydrogen powered urban trains. Germany was the first country to introduce hydrogen powered trains in September 2022.
- > China has launched the world's first Earth-science satellite, named Guangmu or SDGSAT-1.

- Chinese President Xi Jinping on 23 October 2022 was re-elected as the General Secretary of the ruling Communist Party of China for a record third five-year term.
- India's diplomatic prowess at the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) forced China to withdraw its proposal against AUKUS (United Group of Australia, Britain and America).
- Continuing with infrastructure build-up on its side of the area near the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in eastern Ladakh, China is building a new bridge on Pangong Tso.
- First China-Indian Ocean Region Forum on Development Cooperation held in China, India not invited.
- According to the official data released by the Chinese customs, the India-China bilateral trade touched a record high of over USD 125 billion in 2021, up 43.3% from 2020 when bilateral trade was worth 87.6 billion USD.
- China on 1 November, 2022 launched its third and final permanent space station module (Tiangong space station). The name of this lab module is Mengtian.
- According to projections by the World Population Review (WPR), India has surpassed China as the world's most populous nation.
- > As per WPR, India's population was 141.7 crore as of the end of 2022.
- Chinese women's football team defeated the South Korean women's football team 3-2 in the Asian Football Confederations(AFC) women Asian cup final held at the D.Y.Patil stadium in Navi Mumbai on 6 February 2022.
- > This was the 9th title win for the Chinese women's football team also known as "Steel Roses".
- China Manned Space Agency (CMSA) announced that three Shenzhou-14 astronauts successfully entered the Tiangong Space Station on June 6 with the Tianzhou-4 cargo craft.
- According to a report by the United Nations released on 11 July India will surpass China as the most populous country on earth in 2023.
- As per a UN report, the world's population is growing at its slowest pace since 1950. It has fallen under 1% in 2020.
- > Qin Gang Appointed As China's New and Youngest Foreign Minister.

- ✓ Among the personnel receiving Gallantry Awards, 48 are from CRPF, 31 are from Maharashtra, 25 are from Jammu and Kashmir Police, 9 from Jharkhand, 7 each from Delhi, Chhattisgarh and BSF and remaining from other States and Union Territories..

- ✓ About Pariksha Pe Charcha

- ✓ It is a unique interactive program that brings together students, parents and teachers from India and abroad to discuss their concerns related to examinations and life after school.
- ✓ The goal of Pariksha Pe Charcha program is to help participants overcome stress and celebrate life as a celebration.
- ✓ The Department of School Education and Literacy under the Ministry of Education has successfully organised this program for the last five years.
- ✓ Around 102 students across the country will attend the function. This year (2023) is 6th edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha, held every year since 2018

- ✓ India and South Africa on 27 January signed a Memorandum of Understanding to introduce 12 African Cheetahs annually over the next eight to ten year.
- As per the agreement, an initial batch of 12 cheetahs will be brought from South Africa to India during February 2023.
- ✓ These cheetahs will be joined by eight cheetahs brought to India from Namibia during 2022.
- After the import of 12 cheetahs in February, there are plans to move 12 cheetahs annually for the next 8 to 10 years.
- ✓ The initiative to reintroduce the cheetah to India comes after a request from the Indian government, after the species had become locally extinct due to over-hunting and habitat loss.
- <u>Reintroduction Action Plan</u>
- ✓ Reintroduction of a species means releasing it in an area where it is capable of surviving.
- Under the scheme, 50 cheetahs will be released in various national parks of the country over a period of 5 years.
- ✓ Extinction of cheetahs
- ✓ The last cheetah of the country was found dead in the year 1947 in Chhattisgarh and in the year 1952 it was declared extinct in the country.
- ✓ About 'Project Cheetah'

- ✓ This is a one of its kind project in which a species is being brought out of the country (from South Africa / Namibia) and restored to the country.
- ✓ The subspecies of the extinct cheetah in India was the Asiatic cheetah (Acinonyx jubatus venaticus) and the subspecies of the cheetah being brought back to the country is the African cheetah (Acinonyx jubatus jubatus)..
- ✓ <u>Recently news</u>,
- PM Narendra Modi has released wild Cheetahs, which had become extinct from India, in Kuno National Park.
- Cheetahs which have been brought from Namibia are being introduced in India under Project Cheetah, which is the world's first inter-continental large wild carnivore translocation project.
- ✓ Out of the eight Cheetahs, there are five female and three male.
- ✓ The cheetahs are brought under Project Cheetah to reintroduce the big cat in India after they were officially declared extinct in 1952, and the last cheetah was killed in India in 1947.
- ✓ "The proposal for 'Project Cheetah' was prepared in 2008-09...

- ✓ The objective of this program is to reach all the districts of the country on the same day i.e. 27th of every month. EPFO has organised camps in 685 districts of the country.
- ✓ About EPFO
- ✓ Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) is a statutory organisation set up under the Union ministry of Labour and Employment was set up in 1951 by an Ordinance issued by the President.
- ✓ Later Parliament passed the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme, act 1952.
- ✓ It is the country's largest social security organisation.
- ✓ EPFO assists the Central Board of Trustees in the administration of a provident fund scheme, pension scheme and an insurance scheme for the registered establishments in India.

- ✓ The government announced food packages to the Yanomami, where about 26,000 Yanomami live in an area of rainforest and tropical savanna.
- ✓ About Yanomami tribes
- ✓ They are also called South American Indians.
- They live in the remote forests of the Orinoco River Basin in southern Venezuela and the northernmost part of the Amazon River Basin in northern Brazil.
- ✓ They live in small, scattered, semi-permanent villages, speak the Ziriana language, and hunt.
