- ✓ About Garba Dance:
- ✓ It is a ritualistic and devotional dance performed throughout the State of Gujarat.
- ✓ It is celebrated for nine days during the festival of Navratri.
- ✓ The festival is dedicated to the worship of the feminine energy or Shakti.
- The cultural, performative, and visual expressions of this feminine energy are expressed through the Garba dance.
- ✓ The performative and visual celebration of Garba takes place within homes and temple courtyards, public spaces in villages, urban squares, streets, and large open grounds. Garba thus becomes an all-encompassing participatory community event.
- In addition to being a religious ritual, Garba fosters social equality by diluting socio-economic, gender, and rigid sect structures.
- ✓ This dance form is the 15th cultural item from India to make it to the UNESCO list.
- ✓ What is Intangible Cultural Heritage?
- ✓ Cultural heritage does not end at monuments and collections of objects.
- ✓ But also includes traditions or living expressions inherited from our ancestors and passed on to our descendants, such as oral traditions, performing arts, social practices, rituals, festive events, knowledge and practices concerning nature and the universe or the knowledge and skills to produce traditional crafts.

- Chhau, a dance tradition, recreates scenes from epics such as the Mahabharata and Ramayana, as well as local folklore and abstract concepts.

- > Garba dance is the 15th intangible cultural heritage of India to be included in this list.
- Kozhikode in Kerala has been designated as the UNESCO 'City of Literature' and Gwalior as the 'City of Music' in the latest UNESCO list of Creative Cities Network.
- temples of the Hoysala Empire in Karnataka, India were officially added to the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites, marking India's 42nd addition to the prestigious heritage list.
- Three Hoysala-era temples in Karnataka [Chennakeshava (Belur), Hoysaleswara (Halebidu) and Keshava Temple (Somanathapura, Mysuru)] recently made it to UNESCO's World Heritage List, under the collective entry of 'Sacred Ensembles of the Hoysalas'.
- Santiniketan, located in West Bengal, India, has achieved the prestigious status of being recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Santiniketan as the 41st World Heritage Property in India.
- UNESCO have stated in a new report that the Italian city of Venice should be added to a list of world heritage sites in danger.

- ✓ The Ministry of Culture, in collaboration with the Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), has been diligently working on the 'Mera Gaon Meri Dharohar' project. The primary objective is to create a comprehensive cultural map of India by preserving the traditions, art, music, dance, crafts, and customs

- ✓ The activities of the club are divided into three key pillars: -

- Two co-chairs will be elected for two-year terms for the Club. Currently, Germany and Chile serve as the co-chairs.

✓ It specifically aims at educating and enabling CISOs to understand cyber-attacks and get the necessary exposure to the latest technologies for safeguarding e-infrastructure.

- ✓ It also incentives foreign exporters to transition toward cleaner production.
- However, organizations like the World Bank and UN warn that these extra charges could negatively impact developing countries that export to EU, especially industries unable to quickly cut emissions.
  So while CBAM protects EU competitiveness, it may burden trading partners and needs to be designed sensitively.




