- ✓ About Garba Dance:
- ✓ It is a ritualistic and devotional dance performed throughout the State of Gujarat.
- ✓ It is celebrated for nine days during the festival of Navratri.
- ✓ The festival is dedicated to the worship of the feminine energy or Shakti.
- ✓ The cultural, performative, and visual expressions of this feminine energy are expressed through the Garba dance.
- ✓ The performative and visual celebration of Garba takes place within homes and temple courtyards, public spaces in villages, urban squares, streets, and large open grounds. Garba thus becomes an all-encompassing participatory community event.
- ✓ In addition to being a religious ritual, Garba fosters social equality by diluting socio-economic, gender, and rigid sect structures.
- ✓ This dance form is the 15th cultural item from India to make it to the UNESCO list.
- ✓ What is Intangible Cultural Heritage?
- ✓ Cultural heritage does not end at monuments and collections of objects.
- ✓ But also includes traditions or living expressions inherited from our ancestors and passed on to our descendants, such as oral traditions, performing arts, social practices, rituals, festive events, knowledge and practices concerning nature and the universe or the knowledge and skills to produce traditional crafts.

- ✓ In addition, it has been shown to benefit the kidneys.

- ✓ Half of India's energy requirement will come from renewables while reducing carbon emission intensity of GDP by 45% over 2005 levels.
- ✓ The targets underscore India's commitment to fight climate crisis through clean energy even as a developing economy.
- ✓ At COP28, India outlined plans to triple renewable energy capacity by 2030 in collaboration with nations like the UAE.
- ✓ PM Modi presented the Panchamrit (five nectar elements), five time-bound climate pledges to: (1) Reach 500 gigawatts (GW) of non-fossil energy capacity by 2030 (2) Meet 50% of India's energy requirement from renewable energy (RE) sources by 2030 (3) Reduce the carbon intensity of the economy by 45% below 2005 levels by 2030 (4) Reduce total projected carbon emissions by 1 billion tonnes by 2030 (5) Achieve the target of net-zero emissions by 2070.

- ✓ The EU has introduced a new policy called the Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism or CBAM to account for carbon emissions from imported goods.
- ✓ This applies to imports of products like iron, steel and aluminum which require a lot of energy to make and therefore result in high emissions.
- ✓ Under the CBAM, companies importing these goods into the EU will have to buy carbon certificates corresponding to the polluting emissions.
- ✓ This is to ensure imported products face similar carbon costs that European producers pay already under EU emissions rules.
- ✓ The aim is to prevent European manufacturers being undercut by cheaper imports not subject to carbon pricing.
- ✓ It also incentives foreign exporters to transition toward cleaner production.
- ✓ However, organizations like the World Bank and UN warn that these extra charges could negatively impact developing countries that export to EU, especially industries unable to quickly cut emissions.So while CBAM protects EU competitiveness, it may burden trading partners and needs to be designed sensitively.

✓ The Supreme Court recently held that the declaration of State emergency under Article 356 and the subsequent actions of the President should have a "reasonable nexus".

- ✓ About Article 356:
- ✓ Article 356 of the Constitution of India is based on Section 93 of the Government of India Act, 1935.
- ✓ According to Article 356, President's Rule can be imposed on any state of India on the grounds of the failure of the constitutional machinery.
- ✓ This is of two types:
- ✓ If the President receives a report from the state's Governor or is otherwise convinced or satisfied that the state's situation is such that the state government cannot carry on the governance according to the provisions of the Constitution.
- ✓ Article 365: As per this Article, President's Rule can be imposed if any state fails to comply with all directions given by the Union on matters it is empowered to.
- ✓ In simple words, the President's Rule is when the state government is suspended and the central government directly administers the state through the office of the Governor (centrally appointed).
- ✓ Parliamentary approval is necessary for the imposition of the President's Rule in any state.
- ✓ The proclamation of President's Rule should be approved in both Houses of Parliament within two months of its issue. The approval is by a simple majority.
- ✓ The President's Rule is initially for a period of six months. Later, it can be extended for a period of three years with parliamentary approval, every six months.
- ✓ The 44th Amendment to the Constitution (1978) brought in some constraints on the imposition of the President's Rule beyond a period of one year. It says that President's Rule cannot be extended beyond one year unless:
- ✓ There is a national emergency in India.
- ✓ The Election Commission of India certifies that it is necessary to continue the President's Rule in the state because of difficulties in conducting assembly elections in the state.
- ✓ What happens after the President's Rule is imposed?
- ✓ The governor carries on with the administration of the state on behalf of the President. He or she takes the help of the state's Chief Secretary and other advisors/administrators whom he or she can appoint.
- ✓ The President has the power to declare that the state legislature's powers would be exercised by the Parliament.
- ✓ The state legislative assembly would be either suspended or dissolved by the President.

- ✓ When the Parliament is not in session, the President can promulgate ordinances with respect to the state's administration.
- ✓ Revocation of the President's Rule:
- ✓ President's Rule can be revoked any time after such a proclamation has been made by a subsequent proclamation by the President.
- ✓ A proclamation of revocation does not require approval by Parliament.

- ✓ In 1992, at the Rio Earth Summit, 154 countries signed a multilateral treaty called the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- ✓ It aimed to stabilise greenhouse gas concentrations "at a level that would prevent dangerous anthropogenic (human-induced) interference with the climate system."
- ✓ Today, there are 198 'parties' or signatories of the Convention.
- ✓ The first ever COP took place in Berlin, Germany in 1995. The first edition of COP entailed a discussion on how to implement the UNFCCC.
- ✓ At the meeting, an agreement was reached "to meet annually to discuss action on climate change and emissions reductions".
- ✓ COP-8 was held in New Delhi, India. It is the only COP held in India till date.
- ✓ Between 30 Nov to 12 Dec 2023, the Government of the United Arab Emirates is hosting the 28th Conference of the Parties to the UNFCCC (COP-28).

- ✓ As the search for a mutually agreeable position on fossil fuel elimination continued at the COP28 Summit in Dubai, negotiators at the climate meeting took a small first step on initiating greater action on adaptation.
- ✓ Global Goal on Adaptation (GGA):
- ✓ The draft text is titled as 'Global Goal on Adaptation'.
- ✓ GGA is an attempt to identify a common global goal on adaptation, just like keeping temperatures below the 1.5 degrees Celsius threshold is a global goal on mitigation.
- ✓ If the GGA framework is adopted, more than 195 countries will have to do their risk and vulnerability assessment of climate hazards, and formulate their specific national adaptation plans by 2025.
- ✓ They will also have to establish multi-hazard early warning systems and climate information services for risk reduction by 2027.
