

- ✓ Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency Limited (IREDA) is set to invest approximately ₹290 crore in the Upper Karnali Hydro-Electric Power Project.
- ✓ About Upper Karnali Hydro-Electric Power Project:
- ✓ It is a 900 MW run-of-the-river hydropower project being developed on the Karnali River in Nepal.
- ✓ The project will supply power to Nepal, India and Bangladesh for a contracted period of 25 years.
- ✓ The Government of Nepal awarded the project to GMR Upper Karnali Hydro Power Limited (GUKHL), a subsidiary of GMR Group India, under a memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed in January 2008.
- ✓ GMR is developing the project on a build-own-operate-transfer (BOOT) basis.
- ✓ The Nepal Government received 27% free equity in the project as part of the MoU with GMR.
- ✓ It is estimated to generate 3,466 million units of electricity, while offsetting approximately two million tons of greenhouse gas emissions a year.

- ➤ Its function is to encourage projects related to new and renewable energy sources and to provide them financial assistance for their development.

- ✓ Paes & Vijay Amritraj:1st Asian in International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- ✓ Indian tennis legends Leander Paes and Vijay Amrtiraj became the first Indian and first Asian men's tennis players to be inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame in the United States of America.

- ✓ India became the 28th country in the world whose tennis players have been inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- ✓ Along with Leander Paes and Vijay Amritraj, British sports journalist Richard Evans was also inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- ✓ The total number of tennis legends inducted into the Tennis Hall of Fame is 267 from 28 nations.
- ✓ Leander Paes was inducted into the Player Category, while Amritraj and Evans were recognised as part of the Contributor Category
- ✓ About Leander Paes.
- ✓ Leander Paes is considered one of the top doubles players in men's tennis history and has won 18 Grand Slam titles, with ten titles in mixed doubles and eight in men's doubles.
- ✓ He is one of only three men in tennis history to win a Grand Slam in men's and mixed doubles disciplines.
- ✓ The Australian Open, French Open, Wimbledon, and US Open are the four Grand Slam tournaments in Tennis.
- ✓ Leander Paes is the only tennis player in the world who has competed in a record seven Olympics.
- ✓ Leander Paes became the first and, to this day, only Indian tennis player to win an Olympic medal. He won bronze at the 1996 Atlanta Olympics.
- ✓ About Vijay Amritraj
- ✓ Vijay Amritraj was inducted into the contributor category, which honours individuals and groups that have made a significant impact on the sport.
- ✓ He popularised tennis in India and led the country to two Davis Cup finals in 1974 and again in 1987. After retirement, he became a popular tennis commentator and administrator for the Chennai Open Tennis tournament.

- ✓ Indian tennis player Yuki Bhambri, in partnership with Albano Olivetti of France, has won the 2024 Swiss Open Gstaad Men's Doubles title.
- ✓ The Swiss Open Gstaad 2024 was held in Gstaad city, Switzerland, from 15 to 21 July 2024. It is an ATP 250 event played on clay courts.

- This was the 56th edition of the Swiss Open Gstaad Tennis Tournament, which started in 1915.
- 3rd ATP Title for Yuki Bhambri
- ✓ The Swiss Open Gstaad 2024 title was the third ATP (Association of Tennis Professionals) title for Yuki Bhambri.
- ✓ Yuki Bhambri has been more successful as a doubles player. He has won three doubles ATP titles so far.
- ✓ His first ATP title was the 2023 Mallorca Open doubles title in Spain, which he won in partnership with Lloyd Harris of South Africa.
- ✓ In partnership with Albano Olivetti he won the 2024 BMW Open title or the Bavarian International Tennis Championship in Munich, Germany.
- ✓ At the 2024 Swiss Open Gstaad, the Yuki Bhambri and Olivetti pair defeated the French pair of Fabrice Martin and Ugo Humbert in the final played at the Roy Emerson Arena in Gstaad on July 20, 2024
- ✓ Matteo Berrettini wins the Swiss Open Gstaad Singles Title
- ✓ The Italian Matteo Berrettini won his ninth ATP tour title by defeating Quentin Halys of France in the finals. It was his second Swiss Open Gstaad singles title, having previously won the title in 2018..
- The highest-ranked ATP tournaments are the Master 1000, followed by ATP 500 and ATP 250.

- Carlos Alcaraz of Spain defeated Novak Djokovic of Serbia and Barbora Krejcikova of Czech Republic defeated Jasmine Paolini of Italy won the men's and women's single title respectively at the 2024 Wimbledon Tennis Championships
- > Carlos Alcaraz of Spain defeated Alexander Zeverev of Germany and Iga Swiatek of Poland defeated Jasmine Paolini of Italy, won the 2024 French Open men's and women's Tennis Single titles, respectively
- Indian men's tennis player Sumit Nagpal won the men's singles title at the Heilbronn Neckarcup 2024 ATP Challenger Tennis tournament in Germany.
- Sumit Nagpal defeated Alexander Ritschard of Switzerland.

- Rohan Bopanna from India and Matthew Ebden from Australia won the Men's Doubles Title at the Miami Open, a prestigious ATP Masters tennis tournament.
- > Sumit Nagal became the first Indian man to win a match in a Masters 1000 tournament on clay. The top-ranked Indian singles player defeated Matteo Amaldi of Italy.
- Indian tennis star Rohan Bopanna has etched his name in the history books by becoming the oldest player to claim the No. 1 spot in the men's doubles rankings at the age of 43 at the 2024 Australian Open.
- ▶ World number two ranked men's tennis player Carlos Alcaraz and world number one ranked women's tennis player Iga Swiatek won the Indian Wells 1000 men's and women's titles, respectively
- > Indian tennis player Yuki Bhambri and his French partner Albano Olivetti won the 2024 BMW Open tennis tournament title.
- World no.1 women's tennis players Iga Swiatek and Andrey Rublev won the women's and men's singles titles at the 2024 Madrid Open, respectively

- ✓ NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited (NVVNL) will set up two green charcoal plants in Gurugram and Faridabad, Haryana. These plants will convert municipal waste into charcoal or green coal.
- ✓ An agreement was signed between the NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited and the Municipal Corporations of Gurugram and Faridabad in Chandigarh in the presence of the Haryana chief minister, Nayab Singh Saini, and the Union Minister for Power and Union Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Manohar Lal Khattar.
- ✓ India's largest waste-to-charcoal plant is in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, and it can process 600 tonnes of waste daily.
- ✓ NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited (NVVNL), a wholly owned subsidiary of NTPC Limited, will establish the charcoal plant in collaboration with the Municipal Corporations of Gurugram and Faridabad.

- ✓ The plant will be set up in Bandhwari, Gurugram, and Motuka in Faridabad.
- ✓ Each plant will cost Rs 500 crore.
- ✓ The combined capacity of the two plants will be to process 1,500 tonnes of daily collected waste materials into charcoal.
- ✓ The green charcoal will be used in power producing thermal plant which uses coal as a raw material. This will reduce the consumption of mineral coals and hopefully reduce pollution.
- ✓ NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited.
- ✓ NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited was set up by the central government-owned NTPC Limited in 2002.
- ✓ It is in the business of power trading, and the government of India has made it the nodal agency for the cross-border trading of power with Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal.
- ✓ Headquarters : New Delhi
- ✓ Chief Executive Officer (CEO): N K Sharma

- ➤ The NTPC which was earlier known as National Thermal Power Corporation of India is owned by the Government of India. It was set up in 1975.
- ➤ The Vindhyachal Thermal Power Station in the Singrauli district of Madhya Pradesh, with an installed capacity of 4,760MW, is currently the biggest thermal power plant in India.

- ✓ Vikram Misri was on an official bilateral visit to Bhutan from 19-20 July 2024 at the Bhutanese Foreign Secretary Aum Pema Choden.
- ✓ This was the first official visit to any country by Vikram Misri after being appointed as the 35th Foreign Secretary of India in July 2024.
- ✓ India and Bhutan share close political and economic ties based on the Treaty of Perpetual Peace and Friendship, signed in 1949 and revised and updated in 2007 as the India-Bhutan Friendship Treaty.
- ✓ During Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Bhutan in March 2024, he announced that India would provide Rs 10,000 crore for Bhutan's 13th Five-Year Plan.
- ✓ These projects will be financed through Indian assistance of Rs 10,000 crore, as announced by PM Modi.
- ✓ Kingdom of Bhutan
- ✓ Bhutan is a landlocked country in South Asia. It is also known as Druk Yul, which means "Land of the Thunder Dragon."

- ✓ Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, West Bengal and Sikkim share a land border with Bhutan.
- ✓ India shares a 699 km border with Bhutan.
- ✓ Capital: Thimphu

- ✓ It is India's premier R&D institution responsible for the country's research activities in the Polar and Southern Ocean realms.
- ✓ It is tasked with planning and executing polar expeditions and scientific research in Antarctica, the Arctic, the Himalayas and the Southern Ocean.
- ✓ It also researches some of the country's strategically vital projects like mapping of Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ), continental shelf margins and the Deep Ocean Mission.
- ✓ Location: It is located in Vasco da Gama, Goa, and was formerly known as the National Center for Antarctic and Ocean Research (NCAOR).
- ✓ Nodal Ministry: Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India.
- ✓ What is Deep Ocean Mission?
- ✓ It is an ambitious Indian initiative to explore and harness the depths of the ocean.
- ✓ It is a five-year mission, approved by the Union Cabinet in 2021, with a budget of nearly ₹4,077 crore.
- ✓ The mission aims to develop technologies for deep-sea mining, manned submersibles, and underwater robotics, as well as for ocean climate change advisory services, deep-ocean survey and exploration.

- ✓ Madhya Pradesh has secured the first place under the 'Best Performing State' category in the Prime Minister SVANidhi scheme.

- ✓ The micro-credit scheme for urban street vendors, which provides collateral-free loans up to Rs 50,000, was launched by the Narendra Modi government in 2020 during the COVID-19 outbreak.
- ✓ Assam has been ranked second in the 'Best Performing States- Innovation and Best Practices Award' category.
- ✓ In the 'Best Performing ULBs Loan Performance with mega and million plus cities' category, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has received the first place, followed by the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) and the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation
- ✓ PM SVANidhi scheme
- ✓ The PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) was launched on June 01, 2020 for providing affordable Working Capital loans to street vendors to resume their livelihoods that have been adversely affected due to Covid-19 lockdown.
- ✓ Time duration: Initially It was until March 2022. After that it has been extended till December 2024.
- ✓ Eligibility: The Scheme is available for beneficiaries belonging to only those States/UTs which have notified Rules and Scheme under Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.
- ✓ Benefits: A micro credit scheme, facilitating a working capital collateral free loan of Rs. 10,000, with subsequent loans of Rs. 20,000 and 50,000 with 7% interest subsidy.
- ✓ Implementation agency: Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI).
- ✓ Ministry: Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.
