

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

Answer: B

- ✓ 7 New Indian Sites Added to UNESCO Tentative List, Total Now 69.
- ✓ UNESCO has included seven new properties of India in the tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- ✓ Now the number of Indian properties included in the tentative list has reached 69 (49 in the cultural category, three in the mixed category, and 17 in the natural category).
- ✓ Seven new properties, including the natural heritage of the Deccan Traps in Panchgani and Mahabaleshwar in Maharashtra and the Tirumala Hills in Andhra Pradesh, have been included in India's tentative list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
- ✓ India currently has 44 UNESCO World Heritage Sites (36 cultural, 7 natural, 1 mixed), with the recently included Maratha Military Landscapes being the 44th site, making India one of the top countries in the world.
- ✓ India began its journey in UNESCO's World Heritage List in 1983 with four sites (Ajanta, Ellora, Agra Fort, Taj Mahal).
- ✓ Major properties
- ✓ Natural category Panchgani and Mahabaleshwar (Maharashtra), Erra Matti Dibbalu (Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh); Tirumala Hills (Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh); and Varkala (Kerala).
- ✓ Geological heritage Deccan Trap; St. Mary's Islands (Udupi, Karnataka); Meghalaya Age Caves (East Khasi Hills, Meghalaya); Naga Hill Ophiolite (Kiphire, Nagaland) are included.
- ✓ With these, the number of Indian properties included in the tentative list has now reached 69 (49 in the cultural category, three in the mixed category, and 17 in the natural category).
- ✓ About the World Heritage Convention
- ✓ It was adopted by the UNESCO General Assembly in 1972. This convention came into effect in 1975. In 1975, under the convention, the 'World Heritage in Danger' list and the 'World Heritage Fund' were established.

✓ India ratified this convention in 1977. April 18 was declared as the International Day for Monuments and Sites, also known as World Heritage Day.

UNESCO IN NEWS 2025

- India has officially nominated the 'Ancient Buddhist Site, Sarnath for the UNESCO World Heritage List under the 2025–26 nomination cycle.
- ➤ United States will again withdraw from the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).
- > The 'Maratha Military Landscape of India' has become the 44th property of India to be inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- ➤ Uttar Pradesh's Salkhan Fossils Park, located in the Sonbhadra district, has made it to UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- > The Lakkundi group of monuments in Karnataka is being proposed for inclusion on UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- ➤ Port Royal, Jamaica, is currently undergoing the nomination process to be inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
- > The classical ancient Indian texts, Natyashastra and Shrimad Bhagavad Gita, have been inscribed in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register.
- ➤ La Prensa, a Nicaraguan newspaper, was indeed announced as the recipient of the UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize for 2025.
- Two Indian heritage conservation projects—the Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project in Thukkatchi, Tamil Nadu, and the BJPCI Conservation Project of Mumbai, Maharashtra—have won UNESCO's Asia-Pacific Awards for Cultural Heritage Conservation 2024.
- ➤ UNESCO recently designated 16 new Global Geoparks, increasing the total number of geoparks in its network to 229 across 50 countries.
- > UNESCO and the Indian Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) are collaborating on an AI Readiness Assessment (AI RAM) initiative in India.
- > UNESCO has declared West Bengal as a top destination for heritage tourism.
- ➤ Kozhikode made history by becoming the first UNESCO City of Literature in India.
- > India added 6 new properties to its UNESCO Tentative List, increasing the total count of tentative sites in the country to 62.

- ✓ The government has re-opened the application window for the production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for white goods.
- ✓ It is designed to create a complete component ecosystem for Air Conditioners and LED Lights Industry in India and make India an integral part of the global supply chains.
- ✓ It is implemented as a pan India scheme and is not specific to any location, area or segment of population.
- ✓ Objectives: It proposes a financial incentive to boost domestic manufacturing and attract large investments in the White Goods manufacturing value chain.



- ✓ Its prime objectives include removing sectoral disabilities, creating economies of scale, enhancing exports, creating a robust component ecosystem and employment generation.
- ✓ Incentives: The scheme will extend an incentive of 4-6% on incremental turnover over base year (2019-20) of goods sold in India and exported to global markets, to eligible companies for a period of 5 years.
- ✓ Eligibility
- ✓ Applicant can be any company that should be incorporated in India under the provisions of the Company Act, 2013.
- ✓ Eligibility shall be subject to the achievement of thresholds of net incremental sales of Eligible Products for the respective financial year over the base year and cumulative incremental investment in the preceding financial year.
- ✓ Any entity availing benefits under any other PLI Scheme of Govt. of India will not be eligible under this scheme for same products.
- ✓ Time period: It is to be implemented over FY 2021-22 to FY 2028-29
- ✓ Nodal Ministry: The scheme was notified by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

- ✓ Indian Navy has received the second indigenously built anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft INS Andorth.
- ✓ It draws its name from Androth Island in the Lakshadweep archipelago.
- ✓ It is the second of eight anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft (ASW-SWC) built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- ✓ The ASW SWC ships have been indigenously designed and constructed as per the Classification Rules of Indian Register of Shipping (IRS) at GRSE, Kolkata .



- ✓ Features of INS Androth
- ✓ It is approximately 77 meters in length and it is the largest Indian Naval warships.
- ✓ **Propulsion:** The ship is propelled by a diesel engine-waterjet combination, which allows for high speed and efficient maneuverability in shallow waters.
- ✓ **Armament:** It is equipped with state-of-the-art lightweight torpedoes, indigenous ASW rockets, and advanced shallow water SONAR,
- ✓ It enables effective submarine detection and engagement in littoral zones.
- ✓ It strengthens Navy's Anti-submarine, coastal surveillance and mine laying capabilities.
- ✓ It is built by using over 80 percent indigenous content, reflecting growing domestic capabilities and reducing dependency on imports

INS IN NEWS 2025

- ➤ Indian Navy has received the second indigenously built anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft INS Andorth.
- It draws its name from Androth Island in the Lakshadweep archipelago.
- ➤ It is the second of eight anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft (ASW-SWC) built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- ➤ INS Tamal, the Indian Navy's newest stealth frigate, commissioned in Russia on 1 July 2025, concluded a three-day port visit to Casablanca, Morocco, from 6–9 August 2025.
- ➤ INS Himgiri (Yard 3022) was delivered to the Indian Navy at GRSE, Kolkata.
- It is the third ship of Nilgiri Class (Project 17A) and the first of the class built at Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE).
- > INS Nistar is India's first indigenously designed and built Diving Support Vessel (DSV), commissioned by the Indian Navy at Visakhapatnam.
- > Indian Navy's INS Sandhayak made her maiden port call at Port Klang, Malaysia, for hydrographic cooperation.
- ➤ It is the first of the indigenously designed and built Sandhayak-class hydrographic survey ship, which was commissioned in February 2024.
- It was constructed at Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- > Yard 12652 (Udaygiri) being built at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDSL), was delivered



to the Indian Navy.

- ➤ It is the second among the seven Project 17A (P-17A) frigates under construction at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDSL) in Mumbai and Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers in Kolkata.
- ➤ Prime Minister Narendra Modi commissioned three frontline naval warships and submarines INS Surat,INS Nilgiri and INS Vagsheer at the Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL), Mumbai, Maharashtra on 15 January 2025.
- > INS Nilgiri is a stealth frigate and is the lead ship of the Indian Navy's Project 17A, to develop stealth frigates.
- > INS Surat is the last of the four guided missile destroyer class ships to be constructed under Project 15B and INS Vaghsheer is the the sixth and final submarine of the Kalvari class built under Project 75 of the Indian Navy
- Larsen & Toubro (L&T) launched the second multi-purpose vessel (MPV) INS Utkarsh for the Indian Navy.
- Mumbai based Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) marked a key milestone in India's defence capabilities with the delivery of the sixth and final Scorpene-class submarine, INS Vaghsheer, to the Indian Navy.
- ➤ It is the sixth submarine of the first batch of six Kalvari-class submarines for the Indian Navy.
- > INS Nirdeshak is the second ship under the Survey Vessel (Large) Project of the Indian Navy. It is designed to conduct hydrographic surveys, assist in navigation and support maritime operations.
- ➤ It is built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- > Indian Navy is set to commission its latest multi-role stealth guided missile frigate, INS Tushil, at Kaliningrad, Russia
- ➤ Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) Ltd delivered INS Nirdeshak to the Indian Navy. It is the second in a series of four Survey Vessels (Large) being built by the Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers.

- ✓ The mission aims to digitise, catalogue, and preserve India's one crore manuscripts and make them globally accessible.
- ✓ It addresses intellectual piracy by providing authentic sources of traditional knowledge.

- > Government of India has revised the advance registration period to apply for registration on the Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS) 2.0 portal for import of all steel products, except some items.
- ➤ SIMS 2.0 Portal was launched by the Union Ministry of Steel, Government of India.
- ➤ The mobile application "Meri Panchayat" has been internationally recognized with the prestigious World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) Prizes 2025 Champion Award.
- > The Sugamya Bharat App (SBA) has been revamped to provide a more user-friendly and impactful experience.
- Markets regulator SEBI has launched a centralised database portal for corporate bonds in a bid to create a single, authentic source of information on such securities.
- ➤ Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation will launch BHARATPOL portal in New Delhi on 07th January, 2025 in Bharat Mandapam.
- > It will streamline the processing of all requests for international assistance through INTERPOL, including the issuance of Red Notices and other colour-coded INTERPOL notices.
- It is developed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).
- > Financial services secretary M Nagaraju has launched a revamped 'Baanknet' portal that aims to streamline property e-auctions from all public sector banks (PSBs).
- ➤ The Department of Consumer Affairs is launching 'Jago Grahak Jago App,' 'Jagriti App,' and 'Jagriti Dashboard' for public use on National Consumers Day 2024 to protect Consumers from the Dark Patterns.
- Ministry Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, government of India has launched SCAN (Subsidy Claim Application for NFSA) Portal and 'Anna Chakra' to modernise the Public

Distribution System in the country.

- > e-Sankhyiki portal launched by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI).
- > Ministry of Labour & Employment (MoLE) stated that eShram has registered more than 30 crore unorganised workers, showcasing its rapid and widespread adoption among the unorganised workers.
- > About e-Shram Portal:
- ➤ It was launched by the Ministry of Labour and Employment in 2021 for the registration and creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganized Workers.
- ➤ Union Health Minister recently launched the National Medical Register Portal in New Delhi.
- ➤ About National Medical Register (NMR) Portal:
- ➤ It is a portal of the National Medical Commission (NMC) for the registration of all MBBS doctors eligible for registration in India
- ➤ Union Ministry of Women and Child Development recently launched the new SHe-Box portal.
- ➤ About SHe-Box Portal:
- > It is a centralized platform for registering and monitoring complaints of sexual harassment of women in the workplace
- ➤ Uttarakhand government's eSwasthya Dham portal is now integrated with the Centre's Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), allowing 'Char Dham' pilgrims to seamlessly create their national digital health accounts.
- ➤ Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Amit Shah launched four apps—e-Sakshya, Nyaya Setu, Nyaya Shruti, and e-Summon—to ensure the smooth implementation of the three new criminal laws in the country.

- ✓ It was co-chaired by Italy and Japan under the theme "Guardians at Sea", focusing on safer, cleaner, and more secure seas.
- ✓ The aim was to strengthen global maritime governance, enhance cooperation, and share best practices in maritime safety, marine environment protection, emergency response, and law enforcement.
- ✓ Delegates from 115 countries participated, including a two-member Indian Coast Guard team led by Director General Paramesh Sivamani, who presented on India's fire emergency response at sea.
- ✓ India also announced its bid to host the 5th CGGS in Chennai in 2027, coinciding with the Indian Coast Guard's Golden Jubilee

- ✓ m-Kisan is an SMS-based platform that delivers agricultural advisories and services directly to farmers.
- ✓ It enables Central and State government organisations to send messages in farmers' local languages.
- ✓ The portal considers farmers' location and preferred agricultural practices while delivering advisories.
- ✓ It is designed to provide guidance on crops, weather, market updates, and government schemes.

- ✓ It was flagged off by the Defence Minister and symbolises Nari Shakti, the jointness of the Armed Forces, Aatmanirbhar Bharat, and India's maritime vision.
- ✓ Led by Lt Col Anuja Varudkar, a crew of 10 women officers will sail for nine months aboard the indigenously built IASV Triveni, covering 26,000 nautical miles.
- ✓ Their route includes crossing the Equator twice, rounding the three great Capes, and navigating the challenging Southern Ocean and Drake Passage.
- ✓ The mission also integrates scientific studies on microplastics and ocean health, while advancing India's maritime diplomacy globally.

- ✓ It is the organization that prepares and publishes international Standards for all electrical, electronic and related technologies.
- ✓ IEC's mission is to promote, through its members, international cooperation on all questions of electrotechnical standardization and related matters.
- ✓ IEC standards reach over 150 countries.
- ✓ Standardization Management Board (SMB) is an apex governance body of IEC responsible for technical policy matters.
- ✓ The IEC works closely with the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).
- ✓ It is the fourth time India is hosting the prestigious IEC General Meeting, after 1960, 1997 and 2013.
- ✓ It is not an United Nation's specialized agency.
- ✓ It is headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland.

- ✓ In boxing, India's Jasmine Lamboria created history by winning the gold medal at the 2025 World Championship in Liverpool, United Kingdom. The Commonwealth Games medalist defeated Poland's Julia Seremeta by a 4-1 split decision in the fiercely contested women's 57 kg final.
- ✓ 24-year-old Meenakshi Hudda defeated Kazakhstan's Paris 2024 bronze medalist Nazym Kyzaibay 4-1 to claim the women's 48 kg title.

- ✓ Israel-Palestine conflict:
- ✓ Balfour Declaration: The foundation of the Israel-Palestine conflict was laid in 1917 when then British Foreign Secretary Arthur James Balfour, under the Balfour Declaration, expressed Britain's official support for a "national home" for Jews in Palestine.
- ✓ The United Nations presented a partition plan for the creation of an independent Jewish and Arab state in Palestine, which was rejected by most Arab countries.
- ✓ Rise of Hamas: 1987: Hamas was a violent branch of Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood that sought to pursue its agenda through violent jihad. The United States considers it a terrorist organization.

- ✓ As a virtual assistant In January, Diella was initially introduced as an AI-powered digital assistant, designed to look like a woman wearing traditional Albanian clothing.
- ✓ Its purpose was to help citizens navigate the official e-Albania platform, which provides access to documents and services.
- ✓ According to government statistics cited by AFP, Diella has so far helped issue 36,600 digital documents and has provided nearly 1,000 services through the platform.
- ✓ Public tenders in Albania have historically been at the center of corruption scandals. The country has become a hub for international criminal networks laundering profits from drug and arms trafficking, and allegedly corruption has reached senior levels of the government.
