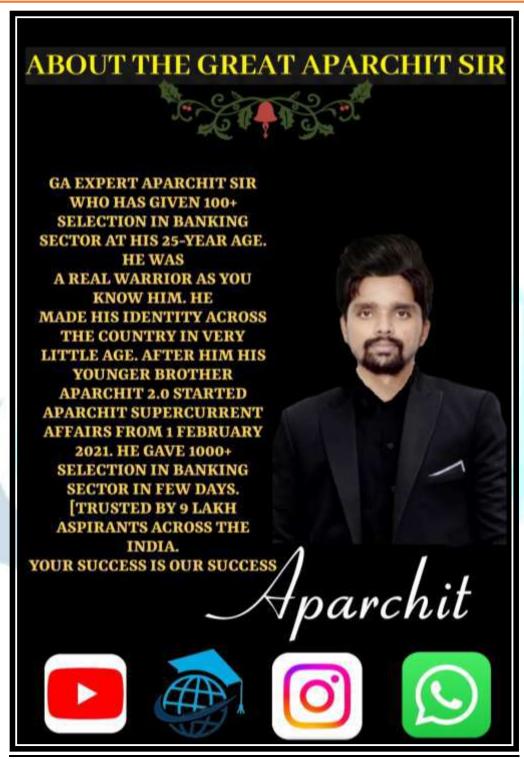

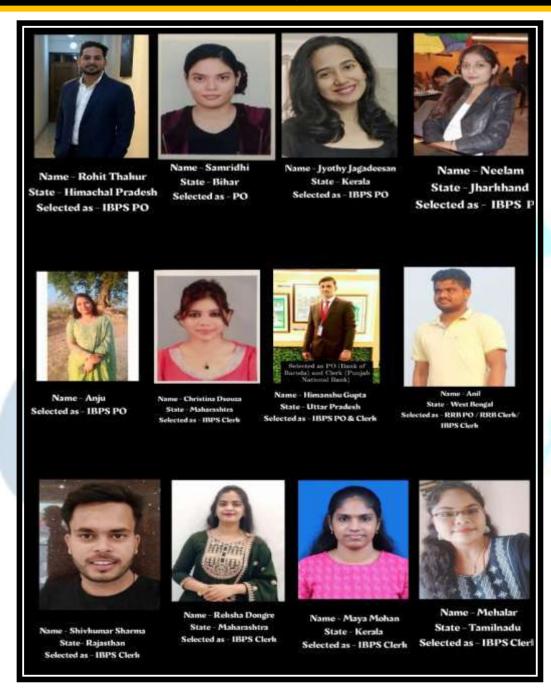

- ✓ NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPL), a wholly owned subsidiary of NPCI, in partnership with Qatar National Bank (QNB), launched QR-based Unified Payments Interface (UPI) services for Indian travelers in Qatar.
- ✓ Key Highlights:
- ✓ First Merchant: Qatar Duty Free, Hamad International Airport, Doha.
- ✓ **UPI Integration:** Qatar becomes the 8th country to adopt UPI, after Bhutan, France, Mauritius, Nepal, Singapore, Sri Lanka, and UAE.
- ✓ **Payment Conversion:** Transactions settle instantly, converting INR to QAR at prevailing forex rates.

✓ **Payment Solution Provider:** NETSTARS, a Japanese Payment Aggregator (PA).

#### **UPI ACCEPTED COUNTRIES IN NEWS 2025**

- ➤ Qatar has become the eighth country to join India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) network for instant digital payments, as NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPL) partners with Qatar National Bank to enable QR code-based UPI transactions at local point-of-sale terminals.
- ➤ Qatar becomes the 8th country to adopt UPI, after Bhutan, France, Mauritius, Nepal, Singapore, Sri Lanka, and UAE.
- Namibia is set to become the first African country to adopt India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) for real-time digital transactions.
- > Trinidad and Tobago has become the first Caribbean country to adopt India's UPI digital payment system via the BHIM app.
- > Cyprus became the second European nation after France to adopt UPI services.
- > Peru is the first South American country to adopt UPI (Unified Payments Interface) technology for its instant payment system.
- Currently, UPI (Unified Payments Interface) is accepted in 8 countries. These are UAE, France, Singapore, Bhutan, Mauritius, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and Qatar

- ✓ The RBI has issued the Authentication Mechanisms for Digital Payment Transactions Directions, 2025, effective April 1, 2026 for domestic payments and October 1, 2026 for certain cross-border card-not-present transactions.
- ✓ All digital payments must follow Two-Factor Authentication (2FA), with at least one dynamic factor (OTP, biometric, token, etc.) unique to each transaction.
- ✓ Factors include something you know (PIN/password), something you have (device/token), and something you are (biometrics).



- ✓ Risk-based authentication is allowed, with issuers applying extra checks for high-risk transactions (e.g., DigiLocker confirmation, behavioural analysis).
- ✓ Exemptions: small-value contactless card payments, recurring transactions (post-first), prepaid instruments, FASTag/NETC, small-value offline payments, and corporate travel bookings.

- ✓ The Cold Desert Biosphere Reserve located in Himachal Pradesh has been included in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network.
- ✓ With this, now 13 biospheres in India have been listed in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network (WNBR).
- ✓ The announcement of 29 new sites was made at the conclusion of the World Congress of Biosphere Reserves held in Hangzhou, China, between 22-26 September.
- ✓ Features of Cold Desert Biosphere Reserve
- ✓ It was first declared a national biosphere reserve in 2009. It includes protected areas such as Pin Valley National Park and Kibber Wildlife Sanctuary, and is home to about 12,000 people.
- ✓ The altitude of this reserve ranges from 3,300 to 6,600 meters, including Pin Valley National Park and Kibber and Chandratal Wildlife Sanctuaries.

#### **UNESCO IN NEWS 2025**

- ➤ Cold Desert Biosphere Reserve located in Himachal Pradesh has been included in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network.
- ➤ With this, now 13 biospheres in India have been listed in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network (WNBR).
- > Ministry of Culture has started consultations to include Chhath Mahaparva in UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.



- ➤ India has officially nominated the 'Ancient Buddhist Site, Sarnath for the UNESCO World Heritage List under the 2025–26 nomination cycle.
- ➤ United States will again withdraw from the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).
- > The 'Maratha Military Landscape of India' has become the 44th property of India to be inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- ➤ Uttar Pradesh's Salkhan Fossils Park, located in the Sonbhadra district, has made it to UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- > The Lakkundi group of monuments in Karnataka is being proposed for inclusion on UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- ➤ Port Royal, Jamaica, is currently undergoing the nomination process to be inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
- > The classical ancient Indian texts, Natyashastra and Shrimad Bhagavad Gita, have been inscribed in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register.
- La Prensa, a Nicaraguan newspaper, was indeed announced as the recipient of the UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize for 2025.
- Two Indian heritage conservation projects—the Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project in Thukkatchi, Tamil Nadu, and the BJPCI Conservation Project of Mumbai, Maharashtra—have won UNESCO's Asia-Pacific Awards for Cultural Heritage Conservation 2024.
- ➤ UNESCO recently designated 16 new Global Geoparks, increasing the total number of geoparks in its network to 229 across 50 countries.
- ➤ UNESCO and the Indian Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) are collaborating on an AI Readiness Assessment (AI RAM) initiative in India.
- ➤ UNESCO has declared West Bengal as a top destination for heritage tourism.
- ➤ Kozhikode made history by becoming the first UNESCO City of Literature in India.
- India added 6 new properties to its UNESCO Tentative List, increasing the total count of tentative sites in the country to 62.

- ✓ Two wetlands of Bihar, Gokul Reservoir in Buxar district and Udaipur Lake in West Champaran district, have been included in the global list of Ramsar Convention sites, bringing the total number of such wetlands in Bihar to five.
- ✓ India added two new Ramsar sites in Bihar—Gokul Jalashay and Udaipur Jheel— raising the national tally to 93 wetlands of international importance, consolidating India's top position in Asia.
- ✓ About Gokul Jalashaya:
- ✓ **Location:** It is located in Buxar, Bihar.
- ✓ It is an oxbow lake located on the southern edge of the Ganga
- ✓ The flood pulses of the Ganges influence land use and land cover in the wetland, exposing marshes and agricultural areas during the dry months and increasing inundation after monsoons
- ✓ About Udaipur Jheel
- ✓ It is located in West Champaran, Bihar.
- ✓ It is also an oxbow lake, bordered to the north and west by the dense forest of Udaipur Wildlife Sanctuary.
- ✓ About Ramsar Sites:
- ✓ Wetland sites of international importance under the Ramsar Convention (1971), promoting conservation and sustainable use.
- ✓ Origin: Signed in Ramsar, Iran (1971); came into force in 1975 under UNESCO.
- ✓ Aim: Protect wetlands as critical ecosystems for biodiversity, water security, flood control, and livelihoods.
- ✓ India and Ramsar Sites:
- ✓ **Current total (Sept 2025):** 93 wetlands across 13.6 lakh hectares.
- ✓ **Growth:** 26 (2012)  $\rightarrow$  93 (2025), with 51 sites added since 2020.
- ✓ Global Standing:
- ✓ India: 3rd in the world (after UK 176, Mexico 144).
- ✓ Asia: 1st in number of Ramsar sites



- ✓ Ramsar Convention and India
- ✓ India joined the Ramsar Convention by ratifying it on 1 February 1982.
- ✓ First Indian wetland sites- Rajasthan's Keoladeo National Park and Odisha's Chilika Lake in 1981.
- ✓ Tamil Nadu has a maximum of 20 sites.
- ✓ Largest Ramsar site: Sunderban of West Bengal (423,000 hectares). Declared Ramsar Site in 2019.
- ✓ Smallest Ramsar: Renuka in Himachal Pradesh (20 hectares). Declared a Ramsar site in 2005.

- ✓ The total number of such sites in India has reached 93, which places the country at the top in Asia in terms of the total number of Ramsar sites and third in the world after the UK (176) and Mexico (144)
- ✓ The number of Indian sites on the list has increased from 26 in 2012 to 93 in 2025, spread over 13,60,718 hectares, of which 51 wetlands have been added since 2020.

- ✓ India has been chosen to the fifteen-member steering committee of the GlobE Network.
- ✓ India was elected to the 15-member Steering Committee of the GlobE Network Global Operational Network of Anti-Corruption Law Enforcement Authorities at its plenary in Beijing.
- ✓ India is represented by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Enforcement Directorate (ED), with the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) as the nodal authority.
- ✓ The GlobE Network, launched in 2021 at the UN General Assembly Special Session against Corruption (UNGASS), now has 121 member countries and 219 authorities.
- ✓ The Steering Committee (1 Chair, 1 Vice-Chair, 13 members) provides leadership and direction to the network.
- ✓ India's election highlights its global role in anti-corruption, financial crime prevention, and asset recovery, aligning with its G20 Presidency (2023) initiatives.
- ✓ Other members include Saudi Arabia, Brazil, Italy, China, Ethiopia, and South Korea, ensuring regional representation.

#### Answer: B

- ✓ The 69th General Conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) was held from 15–19 September 2025 at the Vienna International Centre, Austria.
- ✓ It was organised by the IAEA as its annual policy-making forum, with Peter Burian (Slovakia) elected as President of the Conference.
- ✓ The theme was "Leveraging Science, Technology, and Innovation for Sustainable Development."
- ✓ The aim was to review the IAEA's activities, adopt resolutions on nuclear safety, security, safeguards, and peaceful uses of nuclear energy, and strengthen global cooperation.



- ✓ Other highlights included the Scientific Forum on "Atoms for Water", adoption of key resolutions, and the inauguration of the IAEA Visitor Centre at Seibersdorf.
- ✓ India was represented by Dr. Ajit Kumar Mohanty, Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, along with delegates from 153 member states.

- ✓ NASA launched three space missions to map the Sun's influence in space.
- ✓ NASA and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) have launched IMAP, Carruthers Geocorona Observatory, and the SWFO-L mission to study the Sun's influence in the solar system.
- ✓ A SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket carrying NASA's IMAP (Interstellar Mapping and Acceleration Probe), Carruthers Geocorona Observatory, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)'s Space Weather Follow On-Lagrange 1 (SWFO-L1) missions was launched on September 24, 2025, from the agency's Kennedy Space Center in Florida.

#### NASA IN NEWS 2025

- NASA and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) have launched IMAP, Carruthers Geocorona Observatory, and the SWFO-L mission to study the Sun's influence in the solar system.
- ➤ NASA-ISRO joint satellite NISAR will be launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota, on July 30.
- ➤ GSLV-F16 will inject the Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite into a 743 km Sunsynchronous orbit with an inclination of 98.4 degrees.
- > NASA launched twin satellites as part of the TRACERS mission to study magnetic reconnection and its effects in Earth's atmosphere
- ➤ Dangeti Jahnavi from Andhra Pradesh, will travel to space in 2029. She is the first Indian to complete Nasa's International Air and Space Program.



- NASA's SPHEREx space telescope is slated to launch from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California aboard a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket.
- ➤ The NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite mission is now tentatively scheduled for launch in June 2025.

- Astronauts Sunita Williams and Butch Wilmore returned to Earth after a 286 days stay on the International Space Station. Their SpaceX Crew Dragon capsule splashed down in the Gulf of Mexico off the coast of Florida.
- > NASA astronaut Sunita Williams has made history by setting the record for the most time spent spacewalking by a woman.
- > She logged 62 hours and 6 minutes of spacewalking, surpassing the previous record of 60 hours and 21 minutes held by former astronaut Peggy Whitson.
- NASA will launch the Pandora mission in 2025 to study the atmospheres of distant exoplanets. It will focus on clouds, hazes, and water, key factors for habitability.

- ✓ For unskilled workers, wages are fixed at around ₹514–₹541 per day, while semi-skilled workers will earn ₹516–₹674 per day.
- ✓ For skilled workers, the revised rate is ₹610–₹805 per day, and for highly skilled workers, it goes up to ₹938–₹1,048 per day.
- ✓ The revision applies to sectors such as agriculture, construction, and mines, ensuring protection of real wages against inflation.
- ✓ These rates are revised twice a year (April & October) by the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central).
- ✓ The move aims to safeguard workers' living standards and promote fair wage practices across industries.
