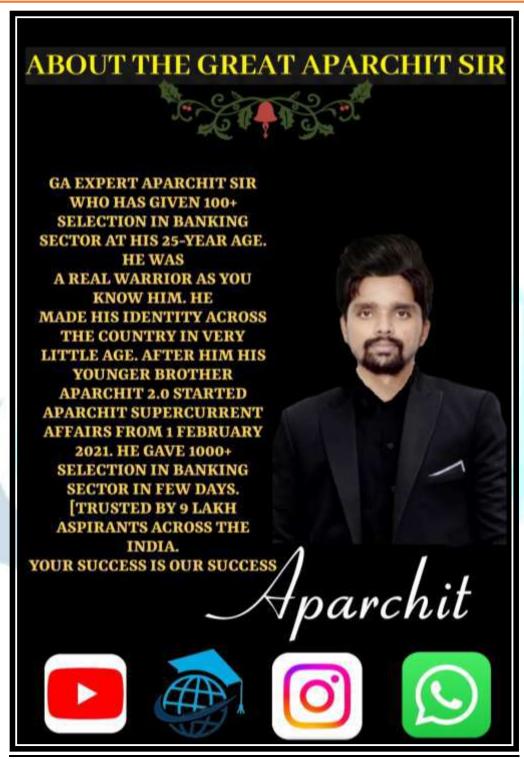

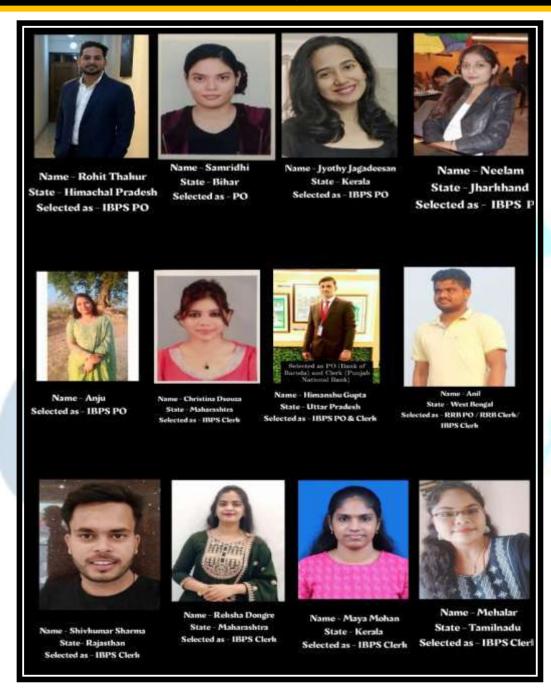

- ✓ The Election Commission of India (ECI) has announced that eligible voters over 85, persons with benchmark disabilities (PwD), and service voters will be able to use a postal ballot for the Bihar Assembly Elections, scheduled to be held in two phases on November 6 and 11, 2025.
- ✓ This provision is made under Section 60(c) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, to ensure greater inclusivity and accessibility.
- ✓ Eligibility and procedure
- ✓ Elderly and PwD voters: Electors aged 85 years or older and those with benchmark disabilities are eligible. They must apply using Form 12D through their Booth Level Officer (BLO) within five days of the election notification. For those who opt for it, polling teams will visit their homes to collect votes, accompanied by security and videography, and candidates can send representatives to observe.
- ✓ **Service voters:** This includes armed forces and state police personnel, as well as Indian government employees posted abroad. They will receive their ballots electronically via the Electronically Transmitted Postal Ballot System (ETPBS) after the list of candidates is finalized, with the Department of Post covering return postage costs.



- ✓ **Statement (A) is true:** The ECI has notified that electors above the age of 85 years can use the postal ballot facility by submitting Form 12D.

- ✓ The Election Commission of India has implemented a multi-pronged strategy to ensure accessible and inclusive elections for PwDs. The measures include:
- ✓ Optional Home Voting: For the first time in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, an optional home voting facility through postal ballot was introduced for PwDs with 40% benchmark disability.
- ✓ Separate Queue: PwD electors and senior citizens are given priority for entering polling booths and have a separate queue.
- ✓ Braille Features: Accessible Voter Information Slips (VIS) with Braille features are issued, and EVMs are equipped with Braille features for visually impaired persons.
- ✓ Transport and Wheelchairs: Free transport, pick-and-drop facilities, and wheelchairs are provided. These can be requested through the Divyang (Saksham) module.
- ✓ **Accessible Polling Stations:** All polling stations are located on the ground floor with ramps of a proper gradient.
- ✓ **Exclusive Polling Stations:** Some polling stations are exclusively managed by PwD officials.

- ✓ **Companion Facility:** Visually impaired persons can take a companion to assist them in casting their vote

- ✓ The Election Commission of India (ECI) has issued directions for improving voting access for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in multiple elections, most recently in October 2025 for the Bihar Legislative Assembly election.
- ✓ These directions are part of the ECI's long-term strategic plan for "Accessible Elections," which aims to enhance electoral participation for PwDs.
- ✓ Facilities and initiatives for PwDs
- ✓ Home voting facility: Eligible PwD voters with a benchmark disability of 40% or more can opt to vote via a postal ballot from their residence. This is an optional, technology-supported service that was introduced and expanded for the Lok Sabha 2024 elections.
- ✓ **Accessible polling stations:** The ECI mandates that all polling stations must be located on the ground floor or be accessible by a proper ramp with the correct gradient for wheelchair users.



- ✓ Priority access: PwD electors and senior citizens are given priority for entering polling booths, so they do not have to wait in the regular queue.
- ✓ **Transport and wheelchairs:** Free transport facilities are provided for PwDs on election day. They can request pick-up and drop-off services or a wheelchair by registering on the Divyang (Saksham) Module of the ECINET platform.
- ✓ Braille features: The ECI provides:
- ✓ Voter Information Slips (VIS) with Braille features for voters with visual impairment.
- ✓ Braille dummy ballot sheets at all polling stations, which allow visually impaired voters to cast their vote independently using Braille features on the EVM ballot unit.
- ✓ **Assistance for visually impaired:** Under Rule 49N of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, a visually impaired voter can take a companion to assist them in the polling booth if needed.
- ✓ **PwD-managed polling stations:** In some elections, including the recent Bihar assembly election, the ECI has set up polling stations that are exclusively managed by PwD staff.
- ✓ Voter awareness and education: Voter awareness materials are created in accessible formats, including audio and high-contrast text, to educate PwD voters. The ECI also engages PwD ambassadors and volunteers from organizations like NCC and NSS to promote voter awareness.
- ✓ Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016: The ECI's actions align with Section 11 of this Act, which mandates accessible polling stations and electoral materials

- ✓ Voters can use 12 alternative photo IDs apart from EPIC to cast their vote.
- ✓ The Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that electors on the voter list can now use any one of twelve alternative photo identity documents in addition to the Electors' Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to exercise their right to vote.
- ✓ This move aims to facilitate voter identification and prevent impersonation at polling stations.



- ✓ EPICs, issued under the Representation of the People Act, 1951, and the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, have already reached nearly 100 percent of electors in Bihar and in the eight Assembly constituencies going to by-elections.
- ✓ The Commission has directed all Chief Electoral Officers to ensure that EPICs are delivered to new voters within 15 days of the final publication of the electoral rolls

- ✓ It features a solid-fuel, ramjet propulsion system, capable of reaching speeds of Mach 2.5 to 3.5 (up to 4,200 km/h).
- ✓ It covers a range of 4.5 km to 25 km and can engage aerial threats flying between 100 meters and 20 kilometers in altitude.

- > DRDO in collaboration with the Strategic Forces Command (SFC), has carried out the successful launch of Intermediate Range Agni-Prime Missile from a Rail based Mobile launcher system.
- This next-generation missile is designed to travel up to 2000 kilometers.
