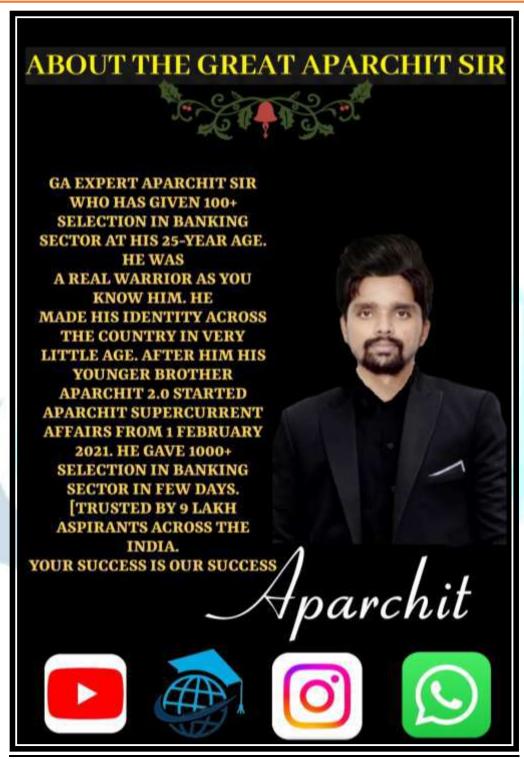

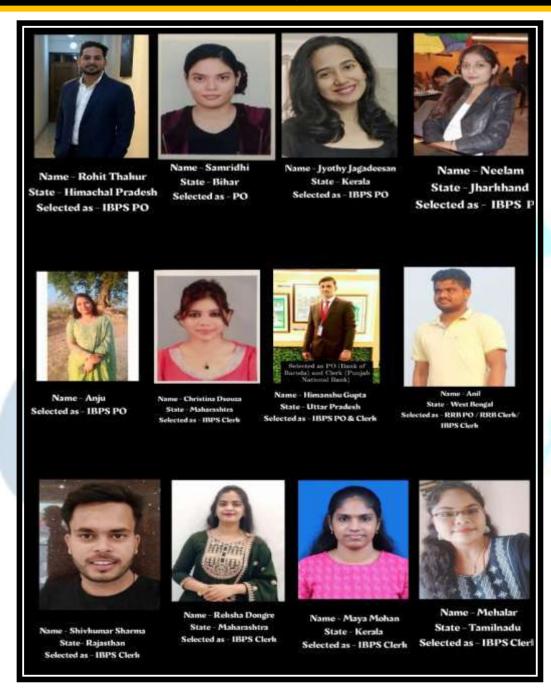

- ✓ Answer Indian Naval Ship (INS) Sahyadri, an indigenously built Shivalik-class Guided Missile Stealth Frigate, participated in the Sea Phase of JAIMEX-25 (Japan-India Maritime Exercise) from 16th–18th October 2025, followed by a Harbour Phase at Yokosuka, Japan, on 21st October 2025.
- ✓ JAIMEX-25 reinforces the 'Special Strategic and Global Partnership' between India and Japan established in 2014, aiming to promote peace, stability, and security in the Indo-Pacific, while reflecting their shared vision of a free, open, and inclusive maritime region.
- ✓ The Sea Phase featured INS Sahyadri, JMSDF ships Asahi, Oumi, and submarine Jinryu, conducting advanced Anti-Submarine Warfare exercises, missile defence drills, flying operations, and underway replenishment to enhance interoperability.
- ✓ The Harbour Phase at Yokosuka focused on professional and cultural exchanges such as cross-deck visits, operational planning, sharing of best practices, and a combined Yoga session, as part of INS Sahyadri's Long Range Deployment in the Indo-Pacific region.
- ✓ Other Excercises: Other bilateral exercises between India and Japan include the Malabar exercise (Naval Exercise), 'Veer Guardian' (Air Force), and Dharma Guardian (Army).
- ✓ About INS Sahyadri:
- ✓ INS Sahyadri, commissioned in 2012, represents India's advancement in indigenous defence technology and aligns with the nation's vision of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' (Self-Reliant India).

- ➤ The fourth edition of India-Australia joint military Exercise AUSTRAHIND 2025 will begin in Perth, Australia.
- ➤ The Indo-Russian joint military exercise 'Indra 2025' is being held from 6th to 15th October 2025, at

the Mahajan Field Firing Range in Bikaner, Rajasthan.

- > The Indian Armed Forces contingent has departed for Russia to take part in the Joint multilateral military exercise ZAPAD 2025, which will be held in Nizhniy, Russia.
- ➤ The 21st edition of the India-US joint military exercise Yudh Abhyas is being held at Fort Wainwright, Alaska, USA.
- ➤ Indonesia and the United States recently launched the annual joint military exercise, Super Garuda Shield 2025.
- ➤ The 14th edition of Exercise Maitree, a joint military exercise between India and Thailand, is scheduled to be held in Umroi, Meghalaya, from September 1 to 14, 2025
- ➤ The 14th India-Singapore bilateral military exercise, code-named "Bold Kurukshetra", commenced at Jodhpur Military Station of the Indian Army in Rajasthan, on 27 December 2025.
- ➤ Indian Navy will participate in the 32nd edition of the Singapore India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX), earlier known as Exercise Lion King.
- ➤ 'Jaa Mata', a Joint Exercise, was held from July 7–12, 2025, off the Chennai coast, marking deeper India–Japan Coast Guard cooperation.
- ➤ The eighth edition of the Indo-French army exercise, 'Shakti 2025', that started on June 18 concluded in France.
- The 6th edition of Exercise DUSTLIK, a bilateral joint military drill between India and Uzbekistan, commenced on April 16, 2025, at the Foreign Training Node, Aundh, Pune, Maharashtra.
- > The eighth edition of the bilateral Indo-French military exercise 'Shakti' begins on June 18, 2025, Camp Larzac, La Cavalerie in France.
- ➤ The first-ever joint special operations exercise between the Indian Air Force and the US Air Force, named "Tiger Claw," took place from May 26 to June 10, 2025.
- ➤ The Indian Army participated in Exercise Khaan Quest 2025, a multinational peacekeeping exercise held in Mongolia. The exercise, co-hosted by the Mongolian Armed Forces and the U.S.
- > The 3rd edition of the India, Egypt military 'Exercise Cyclone' 2025 commenced at the Mahajan Field Firing Range, Rajasthan on the 10th of February 2025.
- ➤ The sixth edition of Exercise Dharma Guardian is scheduled to take place from February 25 to March 9, 2025, at Mount Fuji, Japan.
- > The 18th edition of the India-Nepal joint military exercise "Surya Kiran" has commenced at

Saljhandi, Nepal.

- ✓ India has climbed to the 9th position globally in total forest area and continues to rank 3rd in annual forest gain, according to the Global Forest Resources Assessment (GFRA) 2025 released by the FAO in Bali.
- ✓ About Global Forest Resources Assessment (GFRA) 2025:
- ✓ The GFRA is a comprehensive global evaluation of forest resources, assessing their extent, management, and uses across 236 countries. It provides periodic updates on global forest conditions and trends every five years.
- ✓ Published by: Conducted by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations.
- ✓ Key Summary of GFRA 2025:
- ✓ **Global Forest Extent:** Forests now cover 4.14 billion hectares, with tropical zones (45%) leading, reflecting both rich biodiversity and intense deforestation pressures in these regions.
- ✓ Top 5 Countries: Russia, Brazil, Canada, USA, and China together hold over half of global forest cover, showing how few nations dominate the planet's forest resources.
- ✓ **Deforestation Decline:** Annual global deforestation slowed to 10.9 million ha (2015–2025) due to improved monitoring, policy reforms, and afforestation in Asia and South America.
- ✓ **Forest Gain:** The world added 6.78 million ha of forests annually, driven mainly by restoration efforts in Asia and Europe, showcasing positive ecological recovery trends.
- ✓ **Planted Forests:** 8% of total forests are planted, with Asia contributing 23%, reflecting deliberate human-led afforestation and carbon sequestration programs.
- ✓ **Protected Areas:** About 813 million ha (20%) of forests now enjoy legal protection—an addition of 250 million ha since 1990—boosting ecosystem and species security.
- ✓ **Carbon Stock:** Forests store 714 Gt of carbon, with nearly 46% in soil and 44% in biomass, making them vital buffers against global climate change.
- ✓ **Ownership Pattern:** Around 71% of forests are publicly owned, while 24% belong to private or community holders, underscoring the growing role of inclusive management.



- Global Ranking: India rose to 9th in total forest area and remains 3rd in forest gain, highlighting its consistent policy-driven greening success.

- ✓ **Investment Type:** The commitment is for long-term capital and FDI, specifically excluding Foreign Portfolio Investment (FPI).



- ✓ **Agreement Details:** The investment pledge is part of the TEPA agreement, which took effect on October 1, 2025. It is the first time an Indian FTA includes a binding commitment for target-oriented investment and job creation.

- ✓ The EFTA is a group of four European countries known for being highly developed and innovative, but they are not part of the European Union (EU).

- ✓ The AEO programme operates under the World Customs Organisation (WCO) SAFE Framework of Standards to secure and facilitate global trade.



- ✓ WCO adopted the SAFE Framework in June 2005 to strengthen international supply chain security.
- ✓ AEO is one of the three pillars of the SAFE Framework and promotes customs—trade partnership.
- ✓ It was launched by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) as a pilot in 2011 and revised in 2016.
- ✓ It is implemented by the Directorate of International Customs under CBIC.

- ✓ Prime Minister of India celebrated Deepavali aboard INS Vikrant and hailed armed forces' unity in Operation Sindoor.

- ✓ The ship has been designed in-house by the Indian Navy's Warship Design Bureau and constructed by M/s Cochin Shipyard Limited.
- ✓ It was commissioned into the Indian Navy in 2022.
- ✓ Features of INS Vikrant
- ✓ With a length of 262 metres and a width of 62 metres, the massive aircraft carrier boasts 14 decks.
- ✓ Displacement capacity: Its full-load displacement is 43,000 tonnes.
- ✓ Propulsion: It is powered by four Gas Turbines totaling 88 MW of power and has a maximum speed of 28 knots.
- ✓ Endurance: 8,600 miles (13,890 kilometres) and it is capable of functioning independently for up to 45 days at sea.

- ✓ Transaction volume peaked on Diwali eve (October 18) to 754 million, clocking business worth Rs 1,02,753 crore, according to data from the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
- ✓ UPI comprises almost 85% of all digital transactions, with the average daily volume standing at 695 million in October compared to 654 million in the previous month.

- ✓ **Implemented by:** The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) in coordination with the Ministry of Education.
- ✓ Aim:
- ✓ To create AI awareness among school students and educators.
- ✓ To equip India's youth with industry-relevant AI skills for self-reliance under Atmanirbhar Bharat.
- ✓ To bridge the digital skill gap between urban and rural learners.
- ✓ Key Features:
- ✓ **Structured Learning Modules:** Three 15-hour AI modules for students and one 45-hour advanced module for educators.
- ✓ **Ethical AI Training:** Emphasis on responsible and ethical use of artificial intelligence.
- ✓ Centre of Excellence in AI: ₹500 crore allocated in Union Budget 2025–26 to establish a dedicated Centre of Excellence for AI in Education.
- ✓ **Industry Integration:** Collaboration with IITs, AICTE, and private sector partners to offer specialised AI and ML courses.
- ✓ Digital Access: Integration with the Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) to ensure accessibility for students across rural and urban areas.



- ✓ **Apprenticeship Support:** Under NAPS-2, 1,480 apprentices trained between FY 2022–26 in AI-related roles such as AI Data Engineer and Machine Learning Engineer.
- ✓ **Supports Viksit Bharat Vision:** Advances India's goal of becoming a developed nation by 2047 through technology-led empowerment

- ✓ Kerala: First Indian State Free of Extreme Poverty
- ✓ On 1st November, 2025, Kerala will become the first state in India to be officially declared free from extreme poverty.
- ✓ According to the World Bank, extreme poverty is defined as living on less than USD 3.00 per person per day at 2021 purchasing power parity.
- ✓ In Kerala, the extreme poverty eradication programme, launched in 2021, started with the identification of around 64,000 extremely poor families via ground-level surveys evaluating deprivations in food, health, livelihood, and shelter.
