



#### **ADB IN NEWS 2025**

- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has downgraded India's growth outlook for the current financial year to 6.5% from the 6.7% predicted in April, on account of the impact of the 50% tariffs imposed by the U.S. on imports from India.
- The outlook for 2026-27 has also been revised downwards to 6.5% from the earlier prediction of 6.8%
- L. Satya Srinivas has been appointed as India's Executive Director at the Asian Development Bank (ADB).
- ➤ He will take over from Vikas Sheel.
- ➤ He currently serves as the Chief Negotiator for the India-EU and India-UK Free Trade Agreement (FTA) negotiations.
- ➤ India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) have signed a \$126.4 million loan to promote sustainable, climate-resilient tourism in Uttarakhand's Tehri Lake region.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) (ADB) approved a \$125 million loan on September 1, 2025, for the Assam Urban Sector Development Project to enhance urban livability and climate resilience in six district headquarters and Guwahati.



- Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Green Climate Fund (GCF) launched the \$200 million India Green Finance Facility (IGFF) in July 2025 to accelerate clean energy investments and help India meet its net-zero emissions target by 2070.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) approved a Rs 975.26 crore loan to develop world-class infrastructure in nine industrial areas in Tripura.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a \$109.97 million results-based loan to support Gujarat Skills Development Programme.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has announced a five-year initiative to provide up to \$10 billion to support India's urban transformation.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) is prepared to offer India USD 4-4.5 billion in annual sovereign lending, along with approximately USD 1 billion in private sector financing.
- ➤ ADB's support aligns with India's Viksit Bharat 2047 vision, focusing on urban transformation, private sector development, and skills programs.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Shriram Finance Limited signed a \$150 million loan to expand financing for micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) in India

- ✓ ISRO Unveils Next-Gen Humanoid Robot 'Vyommitra-2' for Gaganyaan Mission.
- ✓ The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) unveiled 'Vyommitra-2', the next generation of its humanoid robot, designed for the crewless Gaganyaan test flights.
- ✓ This sophisticated female humanoid will simulate human functions and environmental controls, playing a critical role in validating the safety of the launch and recovery systems before manned missions.
- ✓ Vyommitra-2 is an upgrade to the first version of the humanoid.
- ✓ It helps ISRO understand the effects of microgravity on the human body.
- ✓ The robot's activities are crucial for human-rating the launch vehicle.

#### **ISRO IN NEWS 2025**

- ➤ ISRO, NewSpace India Limited (NSIL), IN-SPACe, and Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) signed a landmark technology transfer deal on September 10, 2025, for ISRO's Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV).
- ➤ ISRO successfully completed its first Integrated Air Drop Test (IADT-1), which is an important milestone in the preparations for the country's first human spaceflight program, Gaganyaan, on August 24, 2025, at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- ➤ ISRO to launch Block 2 BlueBird satellite in 3-4 months, following successful NISAR mission with NASA.



- ➤ About Bluebird Satellite
- > It is an advanced American communications satellite.
- ➤ It was developed by the U.S.-based AST SpaceMobile.
- ➤ ISRO has inaugurated the Himalayan Outpost for Planetary Exploration (HOPE) space analog mission at Tso Kar Valley (Ladakh) to simulate and study challenges linked to long-duration space missions at 14,000 feet in Ladakh.
- ➤ India aims to set up its own space station by 2035 and conduct a crewed Moon landing by 2040.
- ➤ ISRO launched the NASA–ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite using the GSLV-F16 rocket from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- Mission Life: Designed for minimum 3 years mission life for Earth-Observation (Radar Imaging).
- > Orbital Details: NISAR to orbit Earth at 747km altitude in Sun-Synchronous (Low Earth) Orbit with a repeat cycle of 12 days
- ➤ ISRO plans to launch three navigation satellites by 2026 as part of its Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS), also known as NavIC (Navigation with Indian Constellation).
- The new satellites, designated NVS-03, NVS-04, and NVS-05.
- NavIC is designed to be interoperable with other global navigation satellite systems (GNSS) like GPS (USA), GLONASS (Russia), Galileo (EU), and BeiDou (China).
- ➤ The Cabinet Committee approved \$3.2 billion for the SBS-III programme to develop next-generation satellites over the next decade. Under the programme, ISRO will manufacture and launch the first 21 satellites.
- > ISRO conducted two short-duration hot tests of the Gaganyaan Service Module Propulsion System (SMPS).
- > The tests were carried out at the ISRO Propulsion Complex (IPRC) in Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu.
- ➤ ISRO's 63rd PSLV mission (PSLV-C61/EOS-09) failed due to a technical malfunction during the third stage of the PSLV rocket.
- > Since its first flight, Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) has failed only twice inaugural flight in 1993 and again in 2017.
- ➤ ISRO's 101st launch using PSLV-C61 failed mid-flight, due to a chamber pressure drop during the third stage. The mission aimed to place EOS-09 in Sun Synchronous Polar Orbit.
- > ISRO has successfully developed an indigenous Stellite nozzle divergent for the PSLV's fourth stage,



replacing the previously imported Columbium and significantly reducing import costs by 90%.

- ➤ ISRO achieved its historic 100th launch from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh using the GSLV-F15 to deploy the NVS-02 satellite.
- NVS-02 is the 2nd satellite in the series of 2nd generation satellites of the Navigation with Indian Constellation (NavIC).
- ➤ The GSLV-F15 is the 17th GSLV flight, and 11th with an Indigenous Cryogenic stage.
- ➤ Union Cabinet approved the establishment of the Third Launch Pad (TLP) at Satish Dhawan Space Centre of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- > The government of India has appointed V. Narayanan as the 11th chairman of ISRO and secretary of the Department of Space (DOS).
- ➤ He will succeed the current chairman S.Somanth

- ➤ India's first Central Tissue Bank and a new cashless "We-Office" for the Delhi Dental Council were inaugurated at the Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences (MAIDS), Delhi.
- Agnikul Cosmos Launches India's First Large-Format 3D Printing Facility for Rocket Systems at IIT-Madras.
- ➤ India's first overseas Atal Innovation Centre was inaugurated at the IIT Delhi campus in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates.
- > An Assam-based foundation has developed India's first portal for vulture conservation, called The Vulture Network.
- ➤ The portal was launched on September 2, 2025, by We Foundation India in collaboration with Gauhati University's Department of Zoology.
- ➤ BharatPe and Unity Small Finance Bank (Unity Bank) recently launched the Unity Bank BharatPe Credit Card—India's first EMI-driven credit card on the RuPay network.



- Kerala has become India's first 100% digitally literate state.
- ➤ Banaras Locomotive Works (BLW) installs India's first detachable solar panels between railway tracks, a milestone in Indian Railways.
- > Gujarat has become the first Indian state to launch a Tribal Genome Sequencing Project.
- India's first digital nomad village was launched in Yakten, located in the Pakyong district of Sikkim.
- Fintech firm Slice has pioneered India's first fully UPI-powered bank branch in Bengaluru's Koramangala area
- > Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) in Madhya Pradesh launched India's first digital house address project.
- India's first wildlife corridor on the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway features the country's longest animal underpass and five overpasses near Ranthambore.
- ➤ India's first AI-powered traffic system comes up on Dwarka Expressway in Delhi.
- The ATMS implementation spans the Dwarka Expressway and also a 28-km section of NH-48.
- ➤ Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, inaugurated India's first Non-Banking Financial Company-NBFC in the maritime sector, Sagarmala Finance Corporation Limited-SMFCL.
- ➤ Bajaj Allianz Unveils India's First State-Specific Health Insurance Plans.
- Adani Group has commissioned India's first off-grid 5 megawatt green hydrogen pilot plant in Kutch, Gujarat.
- ➤ Ola's Krutrim, an AI unicorn has launched Kruti, which it claims is India's first agentic AI assistant designed to go far beyond conventional chatbots.
- > Tech professional Swathi Nelabhatla has created the Sitha App, which is India's First Women-Exclusive Gig Platform.
- India's first e-waste recycling park is indeed being developed in Delhi, specifically in Holambi Kalan, North Delhi.
- Andhra Pradesh govt has signed an MoU with the world's largest AI chip maker, NVIDIA, for the establishment of the Artificial Intelligence (AI) University in Amaravati.
- ➤ Kashmir researchers Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST) have successfully developed India's first gene-edited sheep.
- > EnKash has launched India's first unified payment gateway specifically designed for small and



medium businesses (SMBs) and startups. This new platform, called the EnKash Payment Gateway.

- ➤ India's first manned deep ocean mission 'Samudrayaan' into a 6,000-metre depth using the manned submersible vehicle 'Matsya' is expected to be launched by the end of 2026.
- ➤ India's first privately built geostationary orbit (GSO) communication satellite is expected to be ready by 2028. Ananth Technologies, an Indian private firm, is developing this satellite.
- Rajasthan is indeed joining Madhya Pradesh in India's first cheetah reintroduction project.
- ➤ This corridor will link Palpur Kuno National Park and Gandhi Sagar Sanctuary in Madhya Pradesh with Mukundara Hills Tiger Reserve in Rajasthan.

- > IIT- Madras develops silicon photonics based Quantum Random Number Generator
- ➤ In NIRF India Ranking 2025, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras topped the overall category as well as the engineering institutions category.
- ➤ The NIRF 2025 Overall Top 5 are: 1) Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras, 2) Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru, 3) Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bombay, 4) Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi, and 5) Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kanpur.
- > IIT Guwahati researchers developed a bamboo-polymer composite as an eco-friendly alternative to plastic in vehicle interiors.
- > IIT Madras has made India's lightest wheelchair called YD One.
- ➤ Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB), in partnership with IIT Bombay, has launched a pilot V2G project to test its feasibility in the state.
- Coal India joins hands with IIT Hyderabad for R D in clean coal tech.
- > DRDO and IIT Hyderabad unveiled India's largest metal 3D printing machine for rocket components. It was developed at the DRDO-Industry-Academia Centre of Excellence (DIA-CoE) at IIT Hyderabad.
- > IIT Bombay has partnered with the Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) to develop an "Optical Transceiver Chipset for High-Bandwidth 6G Wireless Links."
- > IIT Madras has announced a collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare on Project VISTAAR (Virtually Integrated System to Access Agricultural Resources).
- > IIT-Madras has successfully commissioned Asia's largest shallow wave basin at its Discovery campus in Thaiyur.
- > IIT Madras, in collaboration with the startup TuTr, completed India's first 410-meter Hyperloop test track, marking a significant step forward in vacuum-based train technology.



- ➤ Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IIT Bombay) have developed water-pollutant detecting device called 'AroTrack'.
- > IIT Madras Partners with IDBI To Launch Cybersecurity Lab
- > The Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) partners with IIT Roorkee and Mandi to boost 6G standardization, connectivity.
- > TCS And IIT Bombay Collaborate To Create India's First Semiconductor Chip Imaging Tool.
- Alliance of Digital India Foundation (ADIF) and IIT Guwahati incubation center sign MoU to boost startup ecosystem
- Experimental Licence Module for 100 5G Labs' launched at IIT Madras
- President of India Draupadi Murmu launched India's first domestic gene therapy for cancer at IIT Bombay.
- ➤ French aerospace and defence firm Starburst Accelerator SARLhas partnered with the Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) to set up an innovative hub for start-ups with €100 million in funding support.
- > IIT Madras has developed an indigenous electric standing wheelchair called 'NeoStand,' claimed to be India's most customizable wheelchair for the benefit of wheelchair users
- Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) and the Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee (IIT Roorkee) have collaborated to establish a Centre of Excellence and Industry Accelerator in the automotive and electric vehicle (EV) sector.

- ✓ She married Raja Mallasarja of Kittur and became queen after his death in 1816. The Kittur Rebellion (1824) began after the deaths of her husband and son when she adopted Shivalingappa as the heir to the throne of Kittur.
- ✓ However, the British East India Company refused to recognize Shivalingappa as the successor under the "Doctrine of Lapse" and tried to annex Kittur, which later became one of the earliest examples of the event known as the "Doctrine of Lapse."
- ✓ The Doctrine of Lapse was a policy implemented by Governor-General Lord Dalhousie, under which the British East India Company had the right to annex any princely state under its control if the ruler was deemed incompetent or died without a male heir.
- ✓ Dalhousie applied this doctrine to annex the following states Satara (1848), Jaitpur and Sambalpur (1849), Baghat (1850), Udaipur (1852), Jhansi (1853), and Nagpur (1854).
