

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

- ✓ India's First SiC Semiconductor Manufacturing Plant to be Set Up in Odisha.
- ✓ Chief Minister (CM) of Odisha Mohan Charan Majhi inaugurated India's first end-to-end Silicon Carbide (SiC) semiconductor at Info Valley, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, marking a major step toward the nation's selfreliance in semiconductor manufacturing.
- ✓ The project has been approved under the India Semiconductor Mission (ISM), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).
- ✓ The project, implemented by SiCSem Private Limited, a subsidiary of Archean Chemical Industries Limited, involves the establishment of an Assembly, Testing, Marking, and Packaging (ATMP) and manufacturing facility for SiC-based compound semiconductors.
- ✓ The facility will be built by SiCSem Private Limited in collaboration with UK-based Clas -SiC Wafer Fab Ltd, marking a major milestone in India's semiconductor and power-electronics ambitions
- Rs.2,067 crore; land allotted by Industrial Development Corporation of Odisha (IDCO) (23 acres).
- The facility will have an annual capacity of 60,000 SiC wafers and 96 million packaged units, and is expected to become operational by 2027–28.

- India's first Central Tissue Bank and a new cashless "We-Office" for the Delhi Dental Council were inaugurated at the Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences (MAIDS), Delhi.
- Agnikul Cosmos Launches India's First Large-Format 3D Printing Facility for Rocket Systems at IIT-Madras.
- > India's first overseas Atal Innovation Centre was inaugurated at the IIT Delhi campus in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates.
- An Assam-based foundation has developed India's first portal for vulture conservation, called The Vulture Network.



- ➤ The portal was launched on September 2, 2025, by We Foundation India in collaboration with Gauhati University's Department of Zoology.
- ➤ BharatPe and Unity Small Finance Bank (Unity Bank) recently launched the Unity Bank BharatPe Credit Card—India's first EMI-driven credit card on the RuPay network.
- ➤ Kerala has become India's first 100% digitally literate state.
- ➤ Banaras Locomotive Works (BLW) installs India's first detachable solar panels between railway tracks, a milestone in Indian Railways.
- > Gujarat has become the first Indian state to launch a Tribal Genome Sequencing Project.
- ➤ India's first digital nomad village was launched in Yakten, located in the Pakyong district of Sikkim.
- Fintech firm Slice has pioneered India's first fully UPI-powered bank branch in Bengaluru's Koramangala area
- ➤ Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) in Madhya Pradesh launched India's first digital house address project.
- India's first wildlife corridor on the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway features the country's longest animal underpass and five overpasses near Ranthambore.

- ✓ Swachh Survekshan 2024-25 Awards
- ✓ Conducted by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs since 2016, Swachh Survekshan is the world's largest urban sanitation and cleanliness survey under the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U).

- ✓ Cheetahs will be brought from Namibia, Africa, and released here
- ✓ Due to hunting and loss of habitat, the Asiatic cheetah became extinct in India in 1952.
- ✓ The Government of India launched Project Cheetah on September 17, 2022, under which African cheetahs from Namibia were reintroduced in Kuno National Park (2022) and later in Gandhi Sagar Sanctuary (2024).
- ✓ Kuno now has 25 cheetahs, including nine adults (six females and one male) and 16 cubs born in the park. Nauradehi will now serve as the third site and will be the 25th wildlife sanctuary of Madhya Pradesh.

- ✓ The GEM's main attraction will be the complete collection from the intact tomb of boy king Tutankhamun, being displayed together for the first time since its discovery by British Egyptologist Howard Carter. These include Tutankhamun's magnificent golden mask, throne, and chariots.

- ✓ Except for one, all of the top 10 Indian institutions, including seven IITs, have seen a significant drop in their rankings this year, with institutions from China, Malaysia, South Korea, and Singapore outperforming them.

- ✓ It is an annual religious festival celebrated in late April in the twin villages of Saloor-Dungra, Uttarakhand, in honour of the local deity Bhumiyal Devta.
- ✓ Features of Ramman Festival:



- It features complex rituals, recitations of the Ramayana, songs, and masked dances, with each caste and group playing distinct roles.
- ✓ **Divine Storytelling:** The performances include recitations of the Rama Katha (episodes from the Ramayana), combined with masked dances of deities and local legends, blending mythic and local narrative layers.
- ✓ Sacred Space: It is held in the courtyard of the Bhumiyal Devta temple in Saloor Dungra,
- ✓ Community Participation: Entire village households contribute: roles are caste-based (priests, maskmakers, drum players), funding comes from the village, and participation spans elders to youth.
- There are 18 different types of masks made of Bhojpatra, Himalayan birch, that performers wear during the event.
- ✓ Some of the instruments documented include: Dhol (a type of drum) Damau (smaller percussion drum), Manjira (small hand cymbals), Jhanjhar (larger cymbals), Bhankora (a kind of trumpet).
- ✓ In 2009, Ramman was inscribed in the list of UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

- ✓ NASA astronomers have confirmed the detection of water's chemical fingerprint on the interstellar comet 3I/ATLAS.
- ✓ It is the third known interstellar object from outside our solar system after 1I/'Oumuamua(2017) and 2I/Borisov (2019).
- ✓ It has hyperbolic orbit and travels at 57–68 km/s speed relative to the Sun.
- ✓ It will exit the solar system permanently after a brief interaction with the Sun.
- ✓ It will exit the solar system permanently after a brief interaction with the Sun.
- ✓ This interstellar comet was first seen by a NASA-supported telescope in Rio Hurtado, Chile, which is part of the ATLAS (Asteroid Terrestrial-impact Last Alert System) survey.
- ✓ Physical Characteristics of Comet 3I/ATLAS
- ✓ 3I/ATLAS is confirmed to be an active comet, with a visible coma, a cloud of ice particles and dust surrounding the nucleus.



- ✓ As it nears the Sun, it is expected to develop a tail, a characteristic cometary feature formed by solar heating.
- ✓ Photometric analysis shows a reddish hue suggests the surface may be rich in complex organic compounds or water ice.
- $\checkmark$  The nucleus is estimated to be 10–30 km wide.

#### NASA IN NEWS 2025

- NASA and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) have launched IMAP, Carruthers Geocorona Observatory, and the SWFO-L mission to study the Sun's influence in the solar system.
- ➤ NASA-ISRO joint satellite NISAR will be launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota, on July 30.
- ➤ GSLV-F16 will inject the Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite into a 743 km Sunsynchronous orbit with an inclination of 98.4 degrees.
- NASA launched twin satellites as part of the TRACERS mission to study magnetic reconnection and its effects in Earth's atmosphere
- ➤ Dangeti Jahnavi from Andhra Pradesh, will travel to space in 2029. She is the first Indian to complete Nasa's International Air and Space Program.
- NASA's SPHEREx space telescope is slated to launch from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California aboard a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket.
- ➤ The NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite mission is now tentatively scheduled for launch in June 2025.
- ➤ NASA's IM-2 mission, launched on February 26, 2025, is indeed a significant step in lunar exploration. This mission, part of NASA's Commercial Lunar Payload Services (CLPS) initiative and the Artemis program
- NASA's PACE (Plankton, Aerosol, Cloud, ocean Ecosystem) mission was launched on February 8, 2024. The mission aims to study the health of Earth's oceans and atmosphere by observing plankton, aerosols, clouds, and their interactions.
- ➤ Indian astronaut Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla's Axiom-4 mission (Ax-4) to the International Space Station (ISS) was launched on June 25, 2025 from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida.



- Astronauts Sunita Williams and Butch Wilmore returned to Earth after a 286 days stay on the International Space Station. Their SpaceX Crew Dragon capsule splashed down in the Gulf of Mexico off the coast of Florida.
- > NASA astronaut Sunita Williams has made history by setting the record for the most time spent spacewalking by a woman.

- > Indian Navy has received the second indigenously built anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft INS Andorth.
- It draws its name from Androth Island in the Lakshadweep archipelago.
- ➤ It is the second of eight anti-submarine warfare-shallow watercraft (ASW-SWC) built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- ➤ INS Tamal, the Indian Navy's newest stealth frigate, commissioned in Russia on 1 July 2025, concluded a three-day port visit to Casablanca, Morocco, from 6–9 August 2025.
- ➤ INS Himgiri (Yard 3022) was delivered to the Indian Navy at GRSE, Kolkata.
- ➤ It is the third ship of Nilgiri Class (Project 17A) and the first of the class built at Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE).



- > INS Nistar is India's first indigenously designed and built Diving Support Vessel (DSV), commissioned by the Indian Navy at Visakhapatnam.
- ➤ Indian Navy's INS Sandhayak made her maiden port call at Port Klang, Malaysia, for hydrographic cooperation.
- ➤ It is the first of the indigenously designed and built Sandhayak-class hydrographic survey ship, which was commissioned in February 2024.
- It was constructed at Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- > Yard 12652 (Udaygiri) being built at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDSL), was delivered to the Indian Navy.
- ➤ It is the second among the seven Project 17A (P-17A) frigates under construction at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDSL) in Mumbai and Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers in Kolkata.
- ➤ Prime Minister Narendra Modi commissioned three frontline naval warships and submarines INS Surat,INS Nilgiri and INS Vagsheer at the Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL), Mumbai, Maharashtra on 15 January 2025.
- > INS Nilgiri is a stealth frigate and is the lead ship of the Indian Navy's Project 17A, to develop stealth frigates.
- > INS Surat is the last of the four guided missile destroyer class ships to be constructed under Project 15B and INS Vaghsheer is the the sixth and final submarine of the Kalvari class built under Project 75 of the Indian Navy
- Larsen & Toubro (L&T) launched the second multi-purpose vessel (MPV) INS Utkarsh for the Indian Navy.
- ➤ Mumbai based Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) marked a key milestone in India's defence capabilities with the delivery of the sixth and final Scorpene-class submarine, INS Vaghsheer, to the Indian Navy.
- It is the sixth submarine of the first batch of six Kalvari-class submarines for the Indian Navy.
- ➤ INS Nirdeshak is the second ship under the Survey Vessel (Large) Project of the Indian Navy. It is designed to conduct hydrographic surveys, assist in navigation and support maritime operations.
- ➤ It is built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata.
- Indian Navy is set to commission its latest multi-role stealth guided missile frigate, INS Tushil, at
