

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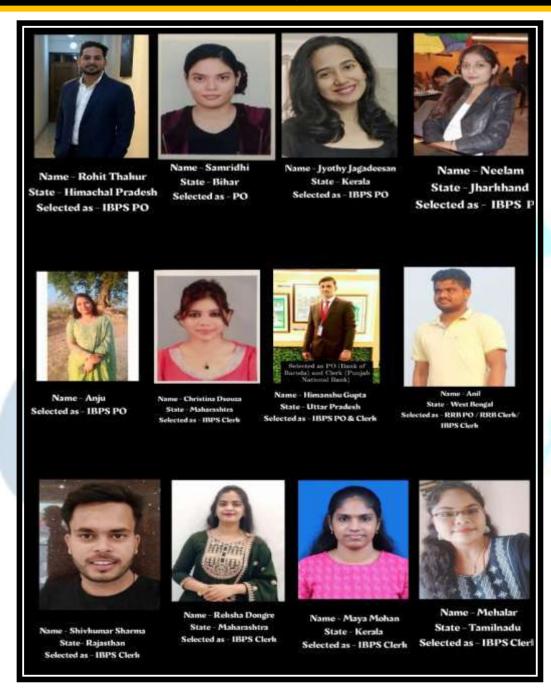

- ✓ RBI has opened up a new avenue for borrowers by allowing loans against silver, in addition to gold.
- ✓ This means individuals can now pledge silver jewellery or coins to avail loans from banks and non-banking finance companies (NBFCs).
- ✓ The new regulations will take effect on April 1, 2026.
- ✓ Who can extend loans against silver?
- ✓ Commercial Banks (including SFBs and RRBs), Urban and Rural Co-operative Bank, NBFCs and Housing Finance Companies
- ✓ What jewellery or coins can be pledged?
- ✓ Gold jewelry up to a maximum of 1 kg
- ✓ Silver jewelry up to a maximum of 10 kg
- ✓ Gold coins up to 50 grams
- ✓ Silver coins up to 500 grams
- ✓ How much loan will you get? (Loan-to-value ratio)
- ✓ The RBI has also fixed the maximum limit of loan-to-value (LTV).
- ✓ Up to 85% on loans up to Rs 2.5 lakh
- ✓ Up to 80% on loans from Rs 2.5 to Rs 5 lakh
- ✓ Up to 75% on loans above Rs 5 lakh
- ✓ This means that if you have silver worth Rs 1 lakh, you can get a maximum loan of up to Rs 85,000 on it.

- ✓ For loans up to ₹2.5 lakh: 85% LTV
- ✓ For loans between ₹2.5 lakh and ₹5 lakh: 80% LTV
- ✓ For loans above ₹5 lakh: 75% LTV

- ✓ The partnership aims to expand access to life insurance for underserved and low-income communities, with a special focus on women, promoting financial inclusion across India.
- ✓ IFC has invested Rs.285 crores (approximately USD 33 million) in Axis Max Life Insurance, through long-dated subordinated debt instruments.
- ✓ The initiative aligns with India's vision of "Insurance for All by 2047," aiming to bolster household safety nets and contribute to a more resilient future

- ➤ IFC has invested ₹285 crore in Axis Max Life to strengthen its solvency margin and boost insurance inclusion in line with India's 'Insurance for All' vision.
- International Finance Corporation (IFC) committed \$150 million to HDFC Capital's H-DREAM Fund in August 2025 to develop affordable, green-certified housing in urban India
- ➤ The International Finance Corporation (IFC), a World Bank Group member, has committed \$60 million to India Business Excellence Fund V G, the fifth fund of Motilal Oswal Alternates.
- ➤ International Finance Corporation (IFC), part of the World Bank Group, is investing \$50 million (approximately ₹420 crore) in Birla Estates to fund two residential projects in Pune (Manjri) and Thane.
- ➤ International Finance Corporation (IFC), part of the World Bank Group, pledged USD 137 million to boost India's e-mobility sector.

- ✓ P H Newby's "Something to Answer For" won the first Booker Prize in 1969.".

- ✓ The International Booker Prize was instituted by the Booker Prize Foundation in 2004.
- ✓ The prize is given to a book that was originally written in a non-English language but translated into English.
- ✓ The translated English version shall be published in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland.
- ✓ It was given every two years, but since 2016, it has been given annually.
- ✓ The first Indian to receive the award was Geetanjali Shree in 2022 for her book Ret Samadhi or Tomb of Sand.
- ✓ The £50,000 prize money.
- ✓ Banu Mushtaq has become the second Indian, after Geetanjali Shree, to win the International Booker Prize.
- ✓ Banu Mushraq's short story collection "Heart Lamp," originally written in Kannada as Hridya Deepa and translated into English by Deepa Bhasthi, won the prestigious literary prize.

- ✓ Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to recognise 'Self-Regulated PSO Association (SRPA)" as the self-regulatory organisation (SRO) for the payment system operators (PSO) sector.
- ✓ The recognition follows the RBI's Framework for Recognition of SRO for Payment System Operators issued in October 2020, and the Omnibus Framework for Recognition of SROs for Regulated Entities of the Reserve Bank issued in March 2024.
- ✓ With this, the financial sector now has multiple officially RBI recognised SROs, including MFIN and Sa-Dhan which represent the microfinance institutions sector, FACE for fintech sector, and FIDC for the NBFC sector.
- ✓ Companies such as Infibeam Avenues (CC Avenue), BillDesk, Razorpay, PhonePe, CRED, Mobikwik, Mswipe, Euronet, Spice Money, Payworld, Unimoni, Open, In Solutions Global, Payglocal, Zokudo, SabPaisa, OxyMoney, and Concerto Software & Systems, have already joined SRPA and several other PSOs have also initiated their membership process and are expected to join the association shortly following the formal RBI approval

- ✓ United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) adopted the "Recommendation on the Ethics of Neurotechnology", the world's first global ethical framework for neurotechnology, during its 43rd General Conference held in Paris, France.
- ✓ The framework sets safeguards to harness neurotechnology for societal benefit while protecting human rights.
- ✓ The standards define "neural data" as a distinct category requiring protection.
- ✓ The neurotechnology sector is projected to exceed USD 30 billion by 2030.
- ✓ UNESCO aimed to eliminate the "Wild West" scenario, where mental privacy, manipulation, and inequality could be out of control

UNESCO IN NEWS 2025

- ➤ UNESCO has adopted the world's first global ethical standards on neurotechnology, addressing privacy, human rights, and data protection amid the rapid rise of AI-driven brain-computer interfaces.
- ➤ Cold Desert Biosphere Reserve located in Himachal Pradesh has been included in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network.
- ➤ With this, now 13 biospheres in India have been listed in UNESCO's World Biosphere Reserve Network (WNBR).
- Ministry of Culture has started consultations to include Chhath Mahaparva in UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.
- ➤ India has officially nominated the 'Ancient Buddhist Site, Sarnath for the UNESCO World Heritage List under the 2025–26 nomination cycle.
- > United States will again withdraw from the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).
- > The 'Maratha Military Landscape of India' has become the 44th property of India to be inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- ➤ Uttar Pradesh's Salkhan Fossils Park, located in the Sonbhadra district, has made it to UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.



- The Lakkundi group of monuments in Karnataka is being proposed for inclusion on UNESCO's tentative list of World Heritage Sites.
- ➤ Port Royal, Jamaica, is currently undergoing the nomination process to be inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
- > The classical ancient Indian texts, Natyashastra and Shrimad Bhagavad Gita, have been inscribed in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register.
- ➤ La Prensa, a Nicaraguan newspaper, was indeed announced as the recipient of the UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize for 2025.
- Two Indian heritage conservation projects—the Abathsahayeswarar Temple Conservation Project in Thukkatchi, Tamil Nadu, and the BJPCI Conservation Project of Mumbai, Maharashtra—have won UNESCO's Asia-Pacific Awards for Cultural Heritage Conservation 2024.
- ➤ UNESCO recently designated 16 new Global Geoparks, increasing the total number of geoparks in its network to 229 across 50 countries.
- ➤ UNESCO and the Indian Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) are collaborating on an AI Readiness Assessment (AI RAM) initiative in India.
- > UNESCO has declared West Bengal as a top destination for heritage tourism.
- ➤ Kozhikode made history by becoming the first UNESCO City of Literature in India.
- ➤ India added 6 new properties to its UNESCO Tentative List, increasing the total count of tentative sites in the country to 62.
- ➤ 1. Kanger Valley National Park (Chhattisgarh)
- 2. Mudumal Megalithic Menhirs (Telangana)
- ➤ 3. Ashokan Edict Sites along the Mauryan Routes

- ✓ Chiang Mai in Thailand and Hanoi in Vietnam rank in the top 4 and 5, each with 88% of residents saying their city makes them happy.
- ✓ Seoul (South Korea), Singapore, and Tokyo (Japan) ranked lower on the happiness list.

- ✓ ISRO announces to land Mangalyaan-2 on Mars by the year 2030.
- ✓ Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has officially announced that the Mangalyaan-2 mission is set to launch in the year 2030.
- ✓ The objective of Mangalyaan-2 will be to land on the surface of Mars with the help of an orbiter and a lander.
- ✓ Twelve years after India made history by launching Mangalyaan, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has officially announced that the country will attempt to land on Mars for the first time.
- ✓ The ambitious Mangalyaan-2 mission is set to be launched in 2030, confirmed by ISRO Chairman Dr. V. Narayanan.
- ✓ It is part of India's growing participation in deep-space missions worldwide following the successes of Chandrayaan-3, Aditya-L1, and NISAR.
- ✓ The Mangalyaan-2 mission is ready to explore Mars and will carry four payloads to study various aspects of the Red Planet
- ✓ Payloads in the Mangalyaan-2 mission -
- ✓ Mars Orbital Dust Experiment (MODEX),
- ✓ Radio Occultation (RO) Experiment,
- ✓ Energetic Ion Spectrometer (EIS), and
- ✓ Langmuir Probe and Electric Field Experiment (LPEX).



- ✓ The study will focus on the atmosphere, environment, and interplanetary dust of Mars.
- ✓ If successful, Mangalyaan-2 will place India among the select group of nations that have landed on Mars
 alongside the United States, China, and the former Soviet Union.
- ✓ <u>Mangalyaan</u>
- ✓ Launched on November 5, 2013, the original Mars Orbiter Mission (MOM) made India the first Asian nation to reach Martian orbit and the first country to do so on its maiden attempt.
- ✓ Mangalyaan was launched from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh, aboard the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV C25) rocket.

ISRO IN NEWS 2025

- > ISRO has officially announced that the Mangalyaan-2 mission is set to launch in the year 2030.
- ➤ ISRO, NewSpace India Limited (NSIL), IN-SPACe, and Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) signed a landmark technology transfer deal on September 10, 2025, for ISRO's Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV).
- ➤ ISRO successfully completed its first Integrated Air Drop Test (IADT-1), which is an important milestone in the preparations for the country's first human spaceflight program, Gaganyaan, on August 24, 2025, at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- ➤ ISRO to launch Block 2 BlueBird satellite in 3-4 months, following successful NISAR mission with NASA.
- ➤ About Bluebird Satellite
- ➤ It is an advanced American communications satellite.
- ➤ It was developed by the U.S.-based AST SpaceMobile.
- ➤ ISRO has inaugurated the Himalayan Outpost for Planetary Exploration (HOPE) space analog mission at Tso Kar Valley (Ladakh) to simulate and study challenges linked to long-duration space missions at 14,000 feet in Ladakh.
- India aims to set up its own space station by 2035 and conduct a crewed Moon landing by 2040.
- ➤ ISRO launched the NASA–ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR) satellite using the GSLV-F16 rocket from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- Mission Life: Designed for minimum 3 years mission life for Earth-Observation (Radar Imaging).
- > Orbital Details: NISAR to orbit Earth at 747km altitude in Sun-Synchronous (Low Earth) Orbit with



a repeat cycle of 12 days

- > ISRO plans to launch three navigation satellites by 2026 as part of its Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS), also known as NavIC (Navigation with Indian Constellation).
- ➤ The new satellites, designated NVS-03, NVS-04, and NVS-05.
- NavIC is designed to be interoperable with other global navigation satellite systems (GNSS) like GPS (USA), GLONASS (Russia), Galileo (EU), and BeiDou (China).
- ➤ The Cabinet Committee approved \$3.2 billion for the SBS-III programme to develop next-generation satellites over the next decade. Under the programme, ISRO will manufacture and launch the first 21 satellites.
- ➤ ISRO's 63rd PSLV mission (PSLV-C61/EOS-09) failed due to a technical malfunction during the third stage of the PSLV rocket.
- ➤ Since its first flight, Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) has failed only twice inaugural flight in 1993 and again in 2017.
- ➤ ISRO's 101st launch using PSLV-C61 failed mid-flight, due to a chamber pressure drop during the third stage. The mission aimed to place EOS-09 in Sun Synchronous Polar Orbit.
- > ISRO has successfully developed an indigenous Stellite nozzle divergent for the PSLV's fourth stage, replacing the previously imported Columbium and significantly reducing import costs by 90%.
- ➤ ISRO achieved its historic 100th launch from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh using the GSLV-F15 to deploy the NVS-02 satellite.
- NVS-02 is the 2nd satellite in the series of 2nd generation satellites of the Navigation with Indian Constellation (NavIC).
- ➤ The GSLV-F15 is the 17th GSLV flight, and 11th with an Indigenous Cryogenic stage.
- ➤ Union Cabinet approved the establishment of the Third Launch Pad (TLP) at Satish Dhawan Space Centre of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) at Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- > The government of India has appointed V. Narayanan as the 11th chairman of ISRO and secretary of the Department of Space (DOS).
- ➤ He will succeed the current chairman S.Somanth
- ➤ Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)
- Founded: 15 August 1969
- > HQ: Bengalore, Karnataka

- ✓ Union Minister Amit Shah, Ministry of Cooperation, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), inaugurated "Coop Kumbh 2025", an International Conference on the Urban Cooperative Credit Sector, held from November 10 to 11, 2025, in New Delhi, Delhi.
- ✓ He launched two digital applications such as Sahakar Digi Pay and Sahakar Digi Loan, designed to modernize the Urban Cooperative Banking (UCB) in India.
- ✓ The Co-Op Kumbh 2025, organized by the National Federation of Urban Cooperative Banks and Credit Societies (NAFCUB), under the Ministry of Cooperation.
- ✓ The event aligns with the International Year of Cooperatives 2025, declared by the United Nations (UN) and the Government of India (GOI)'s aim to strengthen the cooperative sector.
- ✓ The conference was held under the theme titled "Digitalising Dreams-Empowering Communities".
