- ✓ The Ministry of Finance unveiled a new common logo for India's Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) in December 2025 to create a unified brand identity after consolidation under the 'One State, One RRB' principle, featuring an upward arrow (progress), hands (nurturing), and a flame (knowledge), in dark blue (trust/finance) and green (growth/life) to signify financial inclusion and rural development.
- ✓ On the principle of "One State One RRB", the DoFS consolidated 26 RRBs across 11 states/Union Territories (UTs) effective from May 01, 2025.
- ✓ At present, 28 RRBs serve the country through an extensive network of over 22,000 branches across more than 700 districts.
- ✓ The three main elements in the logo reflect themes of progress and growth in rural and remote areas.
- ✓ **Upward Arrow:** This is a symbol of progress, which represents growth, development and advancement in rural economies.
- ✓ **Hands:** This serves as a symbol of nurturing, reflecting care, support and assistance to rural communities.
- ✓ **Flame:** It is the symbol of enlightenment, signifying warmth, knowledge and the empowerment of rural populations.
- ✓ **Logo Colour:** The logo design uses dark blue and green.
- ✓ The dark blue colour signifies finance and trust, while the green colour signifies life and growth.

- ✓ Dark blue signifies finance, trust, stability, and reliability.
- ✓ Green signifies life, growth, agriculture, and rural livelihood.
- ✓ **About Regional Rural Banks (RRB)**
- ✓ Regional Rural Banks (RRB) were set up on the recommendation of the Narasimham Committee on Rural Credit 1975.
- ✓ Five RRBs were set up in India on 2 October 1975. The first, Prathama Bank, was set up in Moradabad (U.P.), sponsored by Syndicate Bank.
- ✓ The power to set up the RRB is vested with the government of India under the Regional Rural Banks Act 1976.
- ✓ RRB is owned by the central government, the state government, and a sponsoring bank.
- ✓ The Reserve Bank of India is the regulator of RRBs.
- ✓ Jammu and Kashmir is the only private bank to sponsor an RRB.
- ✓ Purpose: To bridge rural credit gaps and strengthen institutional lending in rural India.
- ✓ Regulated by: Reserve Bank of India (RBI)
- ✓ Supervised by: National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD)
- ✓ Ownership Structure:
 - ✓ Government of India – 50%
 - ✓ State Government – 15%
 - ✓ Sponsor Bank – 35%.
- ✓ Key Requirements
 - ✓ Must maintain a Capital to Risk-Weighted Assets Ratio (CRAR) of 9%, as per RBI norms.
 - ✓ Must allocate 75% of ANBC (Adjusted Net Bank Credit) or CEOBE (Credit Equivalent of Off-Balance Sheet Exposure) whichever is higher to Priority Sector Lending (PSL).
- ✓ Under the RRB act 1976 the authorized capital of the RRB was Rs 5 crores.
- ✓ Changes made by RRB amendment act 2015
- ✓ The authorised capital of the RRB has been raised from Rs 5 crore to Rs 2000 crores .
- ✓ The minimum issued capital of the RRB has been raised from Rs 25 lakhs to Rs 1 crore.



- ✓ It provides that the combined shareholding of the Central government and the sponsoring banks shall not be less than 51% in any case.
- ✓ There is no RRB in the state of Sikkim and Goa.
- ✓ 11 Public sector banks and one private sector bank Jammu and Kashmir bank are the sponsors of the RRBs.
- ✓ Punjab and Sindh Bank is the only public sector bank which has not sponsored any RRB.
- ✓ The amalgamation of Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) was primarily initiated based on the recommendations of the Dr. V.S. Vyas Committee (2001). However, earlier committees like the Khusro Committee (1989) and Narasimham Committee (1975) also played a role in assessing and influencing the structure of RRBs and later amalgamation proposals

- ✓ This marks 29th foreign state honor conferred on PM Modi, during his 11 year tenure as PM of India.

- ✓ Nnena Kalu, born in 1966, in Glasgow (Scotland), is known for her vivid, abstract sculptures and drawings.
